## 2023-2024 RE-REGISTRATION

The Online Pre-Registration window is now open. We ask for ALL parents of current 7th and 8th grade students to complete the online registration process for the NEXT school year before **April 14th**. Again, this is for EVERY student returning to Thunderbolt or LHHS for the 2023-2024 school year. Online Registration Directions are included in this newsletter. In addition to the online process, there are a few paper forms that must be completed by 7th grade students as well. These forms will be sent home with 7th graders the middle of March. The forms needed are the health office form, proof of AZ residency (include document)., and bus registration, if applicable You have the option to upload proof of Arizona residency; however if you prefer to provide a hard copy of a document, please sign and return the gold form in the packet along with your document. You may also email proof of AZ residency to [susan.blanchard@lhusd.org](mailto:susan.blanchard@lhusd.org), but please return the signed gold form as well. Please make sure to follow the criteria listed on the documentation form. Documentation must be in the name of a parent or legal guardian and have a current address. Please do not send insurance statements, medical bills, or fronts of envelopes as we cannot accept them.

If you do not complete the online process, a full paper packet will be required. If you do not have access to a computer, you may use one in our lobby or request a paper packet from the office.

If your student will NOT be attending Thunderbolt or LHHS next year, please notify the office.

## THUNDERBOLT PTAC

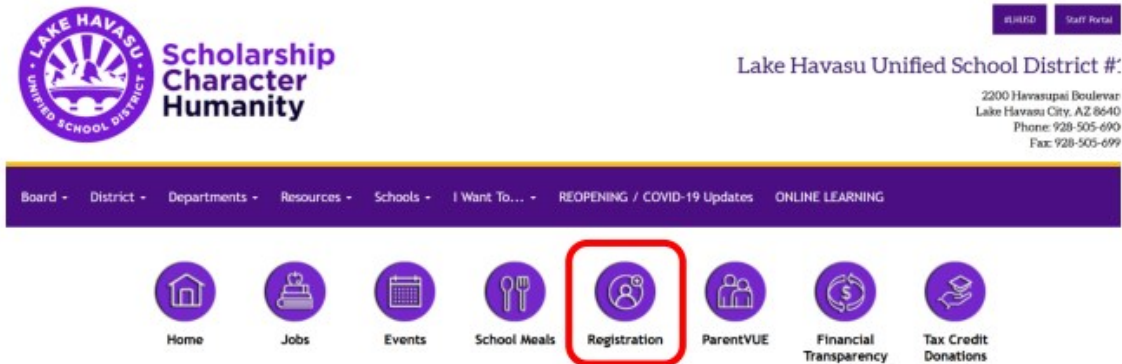

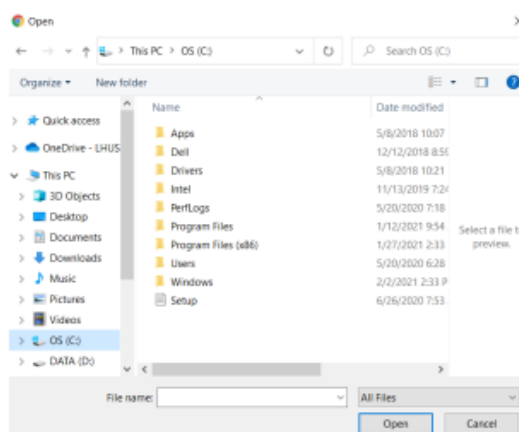
## Online Registration Upload Proof of Residency
