-when the letter *e* comes at the end of a word and is preceded by another vowel, the *e* is silent, making the first vowel sound long.

example- fade, Jane, tame -Single-syllable words with a long vowel sound before the /k/ sound in a word often end in *-ke* example- bake, lake


