Helpful Hints

-when the letter e comes at the end of a word and is preceded by another vowel, the e is silent, making the first vowel sound long.

example- fade, Jane, tame

-Single-syllable words with a long vowel sound before the /k/ sound in a word often end in -ke

example- bake, lake
