COVID has not gone away. If anyone in your house or in close continuous contact with your student has been tested for COVID, please keep them home until you have a result. Keeping exposure at a minimum is important to prevent spreading it.

Please contact the nurse about any testing or exposure. My job is to keep students safe in all areas and I need your help to do this. I don't like to send students home, but ALL students are my responsibility.

Testing is free and there are several sites to go to. Continue to maintain social distancing. Wash your hands frequently. Masks are no longer mandatory but highly recommended. Masks are available in the Health Office. Thank you for helping me keep our students safe.

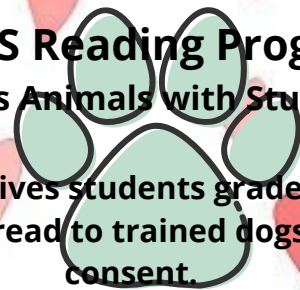
