Rationale:

The Revised School Code provides that board members of Shiawassee Regional Education Service District, Michigan, be elected biennially on the first Monday in June by an electoral body composed of one person designated by the Board of each constituent school district. The designee from the Owosso Schools Board of Education must be directed to cast the vote on behalf of the District by adoption of the resolution that will be presented at the second regular meeting immediately following this.

Facts/Statistics:

- The Revised School Code further provides that this Board shall consider the resolution of designating its representative on the electoral body at not less than one public meeting before adopting the designating resolution. The resolution must be presented no earlier than May 12, 2025 and prior to the actual SRESD election taking place on June 2, 2025.
- The actual election of candidates happens once every two years (biennial). This year the SRESD must elect **two** candidates for six-year terms, and **one** candidate for a partial two-year term. The candidates for the SRESD Board presented for consideration during the Owosso Public Schools Board of Education meeting are as follows:

Six-Year Term Candidates, ending June 30, 2031

- 1. Dr. Timothy Atkinson resident of Owosso Township
- 2. Margaret Sayles resident of Laingsburg

Partial Term Candidate, ending June 30, 2027

1. Janice Ray – resident of Corunna
