## A Note from the teacher:

We are reviewing Unit 2 this week. This means that we will be having our final Reading Comprehension test of the Quarter which will require students to read the passage by themselves. To help prepare them for this please be sure to review our past high frequency words (are said, two, look, my, come, come, here, to, and of) as well as this week's words. They will be expected to read cvc (consonant-vowel-consonant) words with short vowels fluently.

Behind this newsletter I have copied a short vowel passage with comprehension questions that will be similar to our comprehension test. I recommend you to have your child read the story and practice finding the questions within the text.

**Spelling Words:** clip, class, clock, block, black, flick, flag, flat

**High Frequency Words:** want, this, saw, what, put
