2024 Indian Stadium Student Requirements

Groveton ISD has announced a set of guidelines for students entering Indian Stadium for home football games. In order to maintain a safe, orderly and enjoyable atmosphere for all attending, Groveton ISD will implement the following requirements regarding student conduct.

- All students eighth grade or younger wishing to attend home football games must be accompanied by an adult ticket-holder to gain admittance to the stadium.
- Elementary and JH students will <u>not be</u> permitted to enter if only accompanied by a HS aged student.
- There is no limit to how many kids per adult may be admitted as long as the adult ticket-holder agrees to be responsible for each child they bring.
- If a student is asked to leave, no refund will be offered. Adult ticket-holders who bring students into the stadium will be accountable for their behavior
- Students attending football games are expected to sit/stand in the bleachers. Failure to do this will result in students having to be seated with their parents or asked to leave.
- Students are not allowed to bring backpacks, skateboards, bicycles, footballs, hoverboards, or other such items into the stadium.
- No students will play on the grass area near the home or visitor concession stand areas
 or on the cement areas on the side of the stands. If caught loitering in these areas,
 students will be asked to sit with their guardians or be asked to leave the stadium.
- If a student leaves or is found outside the stadium, he/she will not be allowed to reenter.
- All students are expected to leave the athletic complex within 20 minutes after the completion of the game. Please make sure students have a ride arranged.
- All student behavior is expected to be school appropriate. Any student caught
 participating in actions deemed inappropriate by a staff member will be removed from
 the game and not allowed at future games. Student behavior while attending
 extracurricular events are subject to the GISD Student Code of Conduct.
- Any student violating the GISD Student Code of Conduct, within 300 feet of school property or while on the property or at a school-related activity of another Texas district, is subject to disciplinary action.

We appreciate your help with the implementation of these expectations to ensure student safety while giving our fans the opportunity to enjoy the game. Thank you for supporting our football team. The Groveton ISD administration remains committed to maintaining the tradition, excitement and experience for all who attend varsity football games at Indian Stadium. These guidelines are meant as efforts to enhance the safety and enjoyment for all who attend.
