Webster County School District's Dropout Prevention Plan is a collaborative effort to prevent and/or reduce the number of students dropping out of school in Webster County. The goals and strategies listed in the plan serve as a guide to help all students acquire a quality education.

Research has identified attendance, behavior and course performance as proven data points to predict the likelihood of a student graduating from high school. WCSD Dropout Prevention Team recognizes the importance of tracking and monitoring these specific data points as well as others as a means of moving a student back on track to graduation by early identification of issues and matching of specific interventions to best meet the needs of the student.

Overall goal:

• To increase the graduation rate of Webster County School District to 95% each school year.

Initiatives

Goal 1: Reduce the retention rate in kindergarten, first, and second grades.

Strategies:

- Use Extended Learning time (ELT) to target specific academic standards.
- Utilize Tier 2 and Tier 3 interventions to decrease learning gaps in the classroom.
- Use MKAS, Star, and iReady screeners/progress monitoring to identify at risk students.
- Provide specifically designed instruction to meet IEP goals of students with disabilities.
- Provide professional development for teachers on data analysis and instructional strategies.
- Provide a safe, clean, and welcoming environment for students to learn.

Goal 2: Targeting subgroups that need additional assistance to meet graduation requirements.

Strategies:

- Provide specialized remediation through online computer programs.
- Interventionists will provide individualized and small group instruction to remediate students.
- Consultants will provide additional teacher coaching in Math and ELA to target students with disabilities and/or underperforming.
- Webster County CTC allows high school students the opportunity to learn a specific skill.

Goal 3: Provide a dropout recovery initiative that will focus on students aged seventeen through twenty-one, who dropped out of school.

Strategies:

- The leadership teams will monitor results from indicators such as attendance, academic performance, and behavioral issues to help identify at risk students.
- Counselors meet with students and parents to update information in selecting their appropriate graduation pathway.
- Include parental engagement to support student scheduling, academics, and behavioral success.

Goal: 4 Address how students will transition to the home school district from the juvenile detention center.

Strategies

- Provide behavioral interventions by implementing behavior plans.
- Utilize interns from Mississippi State University's Educational Psychology Department.
- Utilize school counselors to provide support to students with social and emotional needs.
- Allow students to meet with administrators, counselors, interventionists, and other staff members to help them set goals for any transitions that the student(s) may need.
