Dear Parishioners,

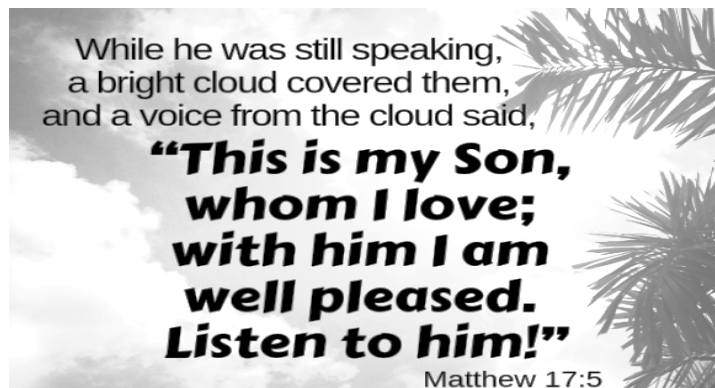
Happy Feast of the Transfiguration. This feast is celebrated August 6, and it is celebrated and trumps Sundays of Ordinary Time. It, of course, commemorates the Transfiguration when our Lord allowed the apostles Peter, James, and John to have a glimpse of His divinity.

What they saw perhaps helped them to endure the scandal of the cross. Perhaps St. John could stay at the foot of the cross knowing that the Lord was God. Perhaps St. Peter could return to the Lord after realizing the cross was not to destroy Him. Perhaps St. James understood that the glory he glimpsed on the mount was to be seen as he gave his life as the first apostle martyr. While we did not witness the Transfiguration, but we can still learn its lesson: Christ is God.
