Moreover, the Board directs the administration to provide Student A with an alternative educational program during the period of expulsion. Finally, the administration authorizes the superintendent, in his sole discretion, to allow Student A to return to Griswold Middle School, on probationary status, at the beginning of the second semester during SY 2024-25 if Student A exhibits appropriate attendance, good behavior, and acceptable academic performance in the alternative program; and refrains from any additional criminal conduct during the period of expulsion. It is further understood that if, upon return to Griswold Middle School, Student A violates any of the conditions outlined above that the Superintendent will reimpose the expulsion for the remainder of the 180-period without having to reconvene a meeting of the Board of Education.
