

		5 Year Capital Projects Mr. Cunningham stated that since the Town Council and Board of Finance have approved our capital reserve requests, projects, including the gutters at Hill and Plain School (HPS), the Northville Elementary School roof study, theater improvements and more are underway. Roof work at the farm house and the canopy at HPS will happen in the spring. They have completed the HPS gutters over the gymnasium, and are moving on to the rear gutters.
