PART 2: PERSONAL INTERVIEW

Upon receipt of complete application packets, candidates will be scheduled for a 30 minute interview with the PTA scholarship committee. During this interview, candidates will be asked to present their Xello profile and career plan.

Other topics to be discussed may include:

- 1. Leadership and service experiences
- 2. Academic and non-academic achievements and challenges
- 3. Plans on how you would use this scholarship award
