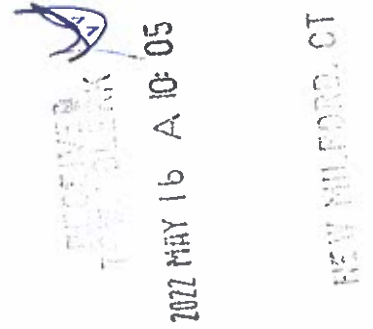

At the May 13, 2022 special meeting that was called for the purpose of holding a student expulsion hearing, a panel of the New Milford Board of Education took the following actions:

Ms. Faulenbach called the special meeting to order at 10:36 a.m. and at 10:42 a.m. Ms. McInerney moved that the Board enter into executive session as personally identifiable information relating to the student who was the subject of the hearing was likely to be discussed, and further moved to invite into executive session all of the named individuals listed above. Ms. Sarich seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

At 11:18 a.m., the Board returned to public session, and made the following motions:

1. Ms. McInerney moved that the Board of Education approve the Stipulated Expulsion Agreement submitted by the parties in executive session and hereby expel the Student discussed in executive session for the term of one calendar year until May 1, 2023, as specified in the Stipulated Expulsion Agreement, and that the disciplinary consequences and other terms set forth in the Stipulated Expulsion Agreement be adopted. Ms. Sarich seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.
2. Ms. McInerney moved that that the parties' Stipulation be adopted in total as the Board's expulsion decision and that a letter be sent to both parties by the Board's procedural advisor reiterating this decision. Ms. Sarich seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

At 11:20 a.m., Ms. Faulenbach moved to adjourn the meeting. Ms. McInerney seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.
