### **UPCOMING EVENTS/PROGRAMS**

- Trunk or Treat- 10/3, 6-7 pm (Brittany Westerfeld leading this event)
  - Needs
    - Additional trunks (currently 20 signed up, Brittany reported she had quite a few sign up in the days before the event last year)
    - Volunteers to wrap baskets Wednesday 10/1
    - Volunteers for raffle sales night of event
    - Brittany to reach out to local fire company to participate
  - o Teachers send PDF copies of list to promote baskets on social media
- The Legend of Sleepy Hollow (Madcap Productions) Friday, October 24
- Costume Parade Friday, October 24
- Popcorn Fridays
  - Moving forward, popcorn will be offered during larger school celebrations when volunteers are already at the school
- Family Fun Event Planning Ice Skating at Goggin Ice Rink (Miami University)
  - 2 hour ice rental (\$630), 2 Ice Guards (\$104), skates (\$3.50/232 student = \$812)
    - Board approves 1 hour skate session for each student + 1 parent chaperone
      - No exceptions can be made due to rink capacity
      - Participation waiver for FCCSC and Goggin Ice Rink will need to be signed and turned in when entering event
      - Chaperone must stay on premise the entire hour
        - o If choosing to skate, chaperones pay for their own skate rental
  - o January/February date TBD based on rink availability
  - $\circ\quad$  Mrs. Lake will send out information and a link to sign up

## **FUNDING REQUESTS**

- Indoor Recess Activities
  - o Brittany Westerfeld reported there is a need for these items ASAP.
  - Suggestion of having activities that promote calm behavior as well as the usual activities
  - $\circ\quad$  Wishlist by teachers/aides will be made and sent to board for purchase.
  - Brittney Doth and Danielle Kist volunteered to donate MagnaTiles and Legos, as well as storage bins for more calm play.

- Playground Improvement
  - Gaga Pit no updates regarding building or donation of materials at this time
  - Shaded area greater urgency than previously discussed rubber mulch per Mrs. Lake
    - Ideally we would create a space that can be used at recess as well as outdoor learning space though any area providing shade is an improvement as there is nothing currently.
    - Mrs. Lake will ask district about requirements and gather information regarding possible structures and their cost
      - A covered pavilion with tables or sunshades were discussed as options with a pavilion being more desirable.
      - Determination of timeline and if additional fundraising efforts are needed will be based on quotes provided

#### **FUNDRAISING**

      - Is there an additional cost for out of area delivery or is that included?
      - Can orders be delivered to school at a greater fundraising return?
      - What profits return to our school?
  - o Texas Roadhouse good timing with holidays and gift cards are popular
  - Timeline TBD -
    - fundraisers need to be at the same time to avoid due date confusion
    - Cannot overlap with spiritwear but needs to be done early enough for pre-Thanksgiving delivery for rolls
