1. Create an account.
2. Select a Medical Exemption when going through the portal.
3. Upload this Physician-signed letter on the *Physician Information* section of the portal.
4. Upon receiving your completed request, Immunization Service will review your request and will either approve or deny the request within 1-3 business days.
5. Upon receiving an approved exemption, you will receive an email notice to log back into the portal to download the approved exemption certificate.
6. Parents/Guardians will be responsible for providing the approved exemption letter to their child's school, child care facility or Head Start program.
