



Kids & Teens EAT FREE this Summer

The Shippensburg Area School District, in partnership with Chartwell's, will offer **FREE breakfast and lunch** this summer - Monday through Thursday starting June 10 through August 1 (closed July 4).

No registration is needed for all kids up to 18 years old, regardless of their family's economic status or district of residence, to obtain a free meal.

All meals must be eaten at the site and cannot be taken home. Parents/Guardians are expected to stay and provide supervision.

FREE breakfasts and lunches will be available for curbside pick-up on Thursdays beginning June 13 through August 1 at the Shippensburg Intermediate School (please use side driveway) between 3:30 and 5:30 pm. Meals will include a complete breakfast and lunch to be consumed on Friday, Saturday and Sunday. There will also be activity pages and/or nutritional info included. A Parent/Guardian **must** pick up the meals (Sorry-no neighbors, friends or group pick-ups). Children do not have to be present when picking up meals.
