DEAR DAD: YOU DON’T HAVE TO EARN YOUR PLACE HERE

A new year often comes with pressure, to do more, fix more, or prove something.

Before anything else, we want you to hear this clearly:

You belong here.

Not because you have all the answers.

Not because you never miss a day.

Not because you fit a certain image of what a father is “supposed” to look like.

You belong because **you matter in your child’s life.**

At Gateway Head Start and Early Head Start, fatherhood isn’t something you earn after doing everything right; it’s something you grow into through presence, effort, and connection.

If you’re expecting a baby, your involvement matters **before the first cry.**

If your child is an infant or toddler, your consistency builds safety and trust.

If your child is a preschooler, your presence supports confidence, curiosity, and self-control.

Some fathers start the year feeling hopeful. Others start tired, overwhelmed, or unsure. Wherever you are, you don’t have to arrive perfect, you just have to arrive.

This year, we’re not asking fathers to perform. We’re inviting fathers to **participate.**

To be seen.

To ask questions.

To learn alongside your child.

To be part of a community that understands fatherhood as a journey, not a test.

You don’t have to fix everything to belong.

You belong now.

Welcome to 2026.

We’re glad you’re here.

You Belong Before You Perform

Fatherhood Reflection: Starting Where You Are

Many dads feel like they need to “get everything together” before stepping in.

But fatherhood doesn’t work that way.

Babies don’t need perfect parents; they need **calm, caring presence.** Toddlers don’t need all the answers; they need **patience and reassurance.**

Preschoolers don’t need superheroes; they need **steady guidance and love.**

Growth doesn’t happen all at once. It happens in small, repeated moments.

If you’re starting this year feeling behind, let this be your reminder:

There is no deadline on becoming the father you want to be.

Start where you are.
Take one small step.
Stay connected.

That’s how belonging turns into growth, for you and your child.

Try This This Month: One Moment of Presence

Choose **one small moment each day or week** to be fully present with your child.

For Expectant & Early Head Start Fathers (Prenatal–3):

- Talk, read, or sing to your baby, even before birth
- Hold your child during feeding or bedtime
- Sit on the floor and follow your toddler's lead in play
- Put your phone down and simply be nearby
- Play together for 10 minutes with no distractions

For Head Start Fathers (Ages 3–5):

- Ask one open question: *"What was your favorite part of today?"*
- Read a short book together (even if it's the same one again)
- Let your child help with a simple task



You don't have to teach a lesson.
You don't have to fix anything.

Just show up.

Because belonging begins with presence, and presence is something every father can give.
