MUSC Hollings Cancer Center's Community Health Van will offer the following vaccines to students ages 9-18 (grades 4-12) who are eligible for the Vaccines For Children (VFC) Program:

**HPV, Tdap, Meningitis, MMR, Polio, Chicken Pox,
Hepatitis A and Hepatitis B**

Children are eligible for VFC until they turn 19, if they meet one or more of the following criteria: Medicaid-eligible | Uninsured | Underinsured | American Indian or Alaska Native
Parental consent is required.

What Parents Need to Know about HPV Vaccination

- The HPV vaccine is FDA-approved and extremely safe and effective.
- The HPV vaccine is for both boys and girls. The optimal age for the first dose is 11-12, but it can be given as early as 9.
- Your child only needs 2 doses if vaccination is initiated before age 15.
- The HPV vaccine is long lasting and protects against 6 different types of cancer.
- Teens are recommended to get 3 vaccines at age 11-12: Tdap, HPV and Meningitis
