#### **SPORTS ELIGIBILITY**

Clarification on High School & Middle School Sports eligibility~

At CAES high school student athletes need to be passing five out of six subjects with a minimum class grade of 2.6 at reporting time to be eligible for athletics and extracurricular activities. At PSD, high school student athletes need to be passing three out of four subjects with a minimum class grade of 2.6 at reporting time to be eligible for athletics and extracurricular activities.

At CAES and SCS, middle school student athletes need to have an "AP" or "P" in five out of six subjects at reporting time to be eligible for athletics and extracurricular activities. At PSD, middle school student athletes need to have an "AP" or "P" in three out of four subjects at reporting time to be eligible for athletics and extracurricular activities.

#### ADDRESSING THE LEARNING CURVE

As we progress through this year's journey of competency-based education (CBE), we will continue to reflect on what can make our grades more reliable, consistent, and an accurate measurement of student learning.

Moving forward right now, based on consultation with experts in the field, we feel it necessary to adjust the grading scale originally set up in Alma to increase the range for "expanding," the highest level in our scale.

New Scale:
0 = 0 - < .5
1 = .5 - < 1.5
2 = 1.5 - < 2.5
3 = 2.5 - < 3.5
4 = 3.5 - < 4

The reason for the shift is that we recognize that at report card and transcript time, the final grade is based on a body of evidence from multiple assignments and assessments. In our original scale, the highest level of "expanding" had virtually no range associated with it -- meaning students could only receive this score with 4s on every single assignment/assessment. What we intended was for the "expanding" designation to apply to students who received mostly 4's, with some 3's, on assignments/assessments.

Likewise, we have adjusted some of the other levels accordingly. We believe this adjusted scale will be a truer picture of student performance.
