CHILD FIND/SEARCH

Child Find is a required and continuous process of public awareness activities, screening and evaluation designated to locate, identify, and refer as early as possible all children with disabilities between the ages of 3 to age 5, and a general education intervention process for children from kindergarten through age 21.

Florence County School District Five presently provides programs or is planning programs/services for children with the following disabling conditions: ***INTELLECTUAL DISABILITIES, DEAF/HARD OF HEARING, DEAF-BLINDNESS, VISUAL IMPAIRMENT, ORTHOPEDIC IMPAIRMENT, SPEECH-LANGUAGE IMPAIRMENT, SPECIFIC LEARNING DISABILITY, EMOTIONAL DISABILITY, TRAUMATIC BRAIN INJURY, DEVELOPMENTAL DELAY, OTHER HEALTH IMPAIRMENT, AUTISM, and MULTIPLE DISABILITIES.***

A special “**CHILD FIND/SEARCH**” is being conducted on **Wednesday, March 30, 2022**, to identify children with a disabling condition. If you have a child that does not attend school who has one of the disabilities listed above, and reside in Florence School District Five, please bring him/her to Johnsonville Elementary School at the following times according to the first letter of your child’s last name:

A-G 8:30 a.m. – 10:00 a.m.

H-M 10:00 a.m. – 11:30 a.m.

N-S 11:30 a.m. – 1:00 p.m.

T-Z 1:00 p.m. – 2:30 p.m.

****If you miss your time slot, please come between 2:30 p.m. – 4:00 p.m.****

During this time, 4K and 5K kindergarten registration will also be conducted.
