

Important Registration Info for the 22-23 School Year

(ALL students, new and returning, must be registered online)

Registration is the process of notifying the school your child will attend the 2022-2023 school year. All students, new and returning, must be registered online.

What is My Username & Password for Online Registration?

Your MCPSS Username will be the enrolling parent/guardian's email address. Your password will be the oldest active student's birthdate.

How to Register Your Child for the 2022-2023 School Year

- Go to www.mcpss.com
- Under "Register," choose one of the following:
 - "Returning Student" (A student who has attended school in MCPSS)
 - "New Students" (A student who has never been enrolled in MCPSS)
- Complete ALL online information and answer ALL questions
- Submit all required registration documents

INFORMATION FOR GUARDIANS WHO WILL NEED TO COMPLETE AN ENROLLMENT ASSESSMENT FORM

If you are in one of the following situations, you will need to complete an ENROLLMENT ASSESSMENT FORM. You can find this electronic form by going to the MCPSS website. Click OUR PARENTS at the top of the page. You will see a drop down list, click RESIDENCE ASSESSMENT. Then you will see that form to complete.

- Living temporarily with a friend or relative due to loss of housing, eviction, economic hardship, or similar reason
- Living in RV parks OR camping grounds due to lack of adequate alternative accommodations
- · Living in emergency or transitional shelters
- Living in public or private place not designed for humans to live
- Living in vehicles, parks, abandoned buildings, bus or train station. etc.
- Migratory children living in the above circumstances
- Unaccompanied youth-child or youth not in the physical custody of parent/guardian
- · Parent/Guardian is recently deceased or incarcerated
- Parent/Guardian is on military deployment and another person has to enroll child
- Student is placed by DHR, court or agency with someone other than the parent/guardian
- Staying in a motel/hotel or pay-by-the-week establishment

If one of these circumstances applies to you, please be prepared to produce the following documentation:

- The person you are residing with OR the contact information for that person
- Your ID and the ID of the person you are living with (person who owns/rents the property)
- Two proofs of residence from the person(s) you are living with: one proof MUST be a current lease, mortgage statement, deed, property tax statement or housing contract AND the second proof MUST be a current utility bill (i.e., power, water, gas) associated with the property address
- Any official mail/bill coming to the residence/address in the parent's/guardian's name (example: hospital bill, government assistance letter, etc.)
- If you are living in a motel/hotel or a pay-by--the-week establishment, you will need a CURRENT rent receipt with the name of the establishment
