#### SUBJECT: SPORTS AND THE ATHLETIC PROGRAM

Athletics are an integral part of a well-balanced educational program. Therefore, the Board supports within its resources a broad sports program with equal access for both males and females, with an emphasis on maximum participation, through interscholastic and intramural activity. The District will comply with recommendations from the U.S. Department of Education's Office for Civil Rights (OCR) regarding Title IX equal opportunity for males and females in the District's total athletic program regarding any of the following factors which may be applicable:

- a) The nature and extent of the sports program to be offered (including the levels of competition, such as varsity, club, etc.);
- b) The provision of equipment and supplies;
- c) The scheduling of games and practice time;
- d) The provision of travel and per diem allowances;
- e) The nature and extent of the opportunity to receive coaching and academic tutoring;
- f) The assignment and compensation of coaches and tutors;
- g) The provision of locker rooms, practice and competitive facilities;
- h) The provision of medical and training facilities and services;
- i) The provision of housing and dining facilities and services; and
- j) The nature and extent of support, publicity and promotion including cheerleading, bands, published programs distributed at games, and booster club activities.

The interscholastic athletic program shall conform to the Regulations of the Commissioner of Education as well as the established rules of the New York State Public High Schools Athletic Association and the State Education Department.

Eligibility for interscholastic athletic competition requires that the students:

- a) Provide written parental/guardian consent;
- b) Pass satisfactorily the medical examination administered by the school physician/nurse practitioner or the student's personal physician. The school physician/nurse practitioner/school nurse (under the direction of the school physician) retains final approval on all physicals performed by the student's personal physician; and

#### SUBJECT: SPORTS AND THE ATHLETIC PROGRAM (Cont'd)

c) Meet the requirements for interscholastic competition as set forth by the Commissioner's Regulations and the New York State Public High School Athletic Association.

#### **Booster Clubs**

The School District has a responsibility under Title IX to ensure that boys' and girls' programs are provided with equivalent benefits, treatment, services and opportunities regardless of their source. When determining equivalency, benefits, services and opportunities attained through the use of private funds (e.g., "booster clubs"), such funds are considered in combination with all benefits, services and opportunities.

Private fundraising, including student-initiated fundraising, is permissible under Title IX. Further, compliance with Title IX does not mean that teams must "share" proceeds from fundraising activities. It does, however, place a responsibility on the District to ensure that benefits, services, treatment and opportunities overall, regardless of funding sources, are equivalent for male and female athletes.

In accordance with OCR, in order for the District to be in continuing compliance with Title IX requirements, the District must assure that services, benefits and opportunities in its athletic programs are provided on an equivalent basis to both boys and girls, including those services, benefits and opportunities that are provided through the use of outside financial assistance such as donations, fundraising by coaches, and booster clubs.

#### **Athletic Placement Process**

The Board approves the use of the athletic placement process authorized by §135.4(c)(7)(ii)(a)(4)of the Regulations of the Commissioner of Education in order to permit pupils in grades no lower than seventh grade to compete on interscholastic athletic teams organized for senior high school pupils, and senior high school pupils to compete on interscholastic athletic teams organized for pupils in the seventh and eighth grades; when appropriate to their physical maturity, physical fitness and sports skills in relation to other pupils, and in accordance with the standards established by the Commissioner.

#### **Student Athletic Injuries**

No student should be allowed to practice or play in an athletic contest if he/she is suffering from an injury. The diagnosis of and prescription of treatment for injuries is strictly a medical matter and should under no circumstances be considered within the province of the coach. A coach's responsibility is to see that injured players are given prompt and competent medical attention, and that all details of a doctor's instructions concerning the student's functioning as a team member are carried out. No student will be allowed to practice or compete if there is a question whether he/she is in adequate physical condition.

A physician's certificate may be required before an athlete is permitted to return to practice or competition.

#### Athletic Program - Safety

The District will take reasonable steps to see that physical risks to students participating in the interscholastic athletic program shall be kept at a minimum by:

- a) Requiring medical examinations of participants;
- b) Obtaining appropriately certified and/or licensed officials to coach all varsity, junior varsity, and modified games; and
- c) Ensuring the equipment is both safe and operative within approved guidelines.

# STATE UNIVERSITY OF NEW YORK AT STONY BROOK SHORT TERM FACILITIES USE PERMIT

This Revocable Permit Agreement is made this 2<sup>nd</sup> day of October, 2015, by and between the State University of New York ("SUNY"), a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of New York, with its principal place of business located at State University Plaza, Albany, New York, 12246, for and on behalf of SUNY at Stony Brook ("University") and The East Hampton School District ("Permittee"), with its principal place of business located at 4 Long Lane, East Hampton, NY 11937. Subject to and in consideration of mutual covenants, terms and conditions hereinafter set forth, the parties hereto agree as follows:

- 1. Access to a portion of the University campus described in Exhibit B attached hereto shall be provided to Permittee on November 3, 2015, during the hours of 6:30 AM to 3:30 PM.
- 2. Permittee shall use the space solely for the purpose of conducting the following event:

  The East End ESL/Bilingual Teachers Academy.
- 3. Permittee shall compensate the University according to the fee amounts and schedule outlined in Exhibit B. Payment is due the University within 30 days from Permittee's receipt of the billing invoice.
- 4. The University shall supply all ordinary and necessary water, gas, electricity, light, heat and sewage services for the premises. The University does not provide telephone service.
- 5. Permittee assumes all risk incidental to the use of said space and facilities and shall be solely responsible for any and all accidents or injuries to property or persons (including death) arising out of or in connection with the event. Permittee agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the State of New York, the State University of New York and State University of New York at Stony Brook from any and all claims, suits, actions, damages and costs arising out of or relating to the use of the space and facilities, or the violation by Permittee or its agents, employees and/or visitors of any law, code, order, ordinance, rule or regulation in connection with the event.
- 6. Before the effective date of this Permit, Permittees shall carry, at their own expense, general liability insurance in the amount of two million (\$2,000,000) dollars per occurrence and

three million (\$3,000,000) dollars in the aggregate, and naming the State of New York, the State University of New York and the State University of New York at Stony Brook as "additional insureds", for liability coverage for acts committed by or suffered by Permittee's agents, employees, invitees and/or visitors. A Certificate of Insurance must be provided and must be accompanied by a completed Certification by Insurance Broker form. Such insurance shall remain in effect throughout the term of this Permit.

- 7. Permittee shall be responsible for the safe, calm and orderly conduct of the event and its programs. University shall notify and coordinate the activities of the Permittee with the University Police Department at least two weeks prior to the scheduled event.
- 8. Permittee specifically agrees not to hold itself out as representing the State of New York or State University of New York at Stony Brook in connection with its use of the space or facilities. Descriptions of all advertising for the purpose of promoting this event are attached as Exhibit C.
- 9. Permittee shall submit a list of all potential corporate sponsors for the events to Laura Lyons (scheduling coordinator) at least two months prior to the date of the event. In accordance with campus policies, the University has the unilateral right to refuse any corporate sponsor access to its facilities.
- 10. Permittee shall comply with all University regulations and policies and with all applicable State, federal and municipal laws, rules, orders, regulations and requirements, and shall obtain and keep in force at its sole cost and expense, any permits or licenses that may be required in this jurisdiction. Permittee further agrees to the terms and conditions set forth in Exhibit A and A-1 attached hereto and incorporated herein.
- 11. The University may also revoke this facilities use permit immediately without cause. Notice shall be served in writing to the Permittee at the following address:

- 13. Signs can only be displayed at the Main Entrance gate within the Stony Brook University Main Campus. Signs cannot be displayed off the Stony Brook Campus property. Signage should be limited to name of event, date, time and location and not contain advertising material. Signs should be professionally produced. Signs may not be put up until the day of the event and must be removed at the end of the event. The Permittee is responsible for contacting Laura Lyons, (scheduling coordinator) in regard to the installation and removal of the signs. The signs must be approved one week prior to the event by Laura Lyons (scheduling coordinator).
- 14. Prior to departure from the premises, Permittee shall restore the site to its original condition, at its sole expense. If such restoration is not completed to the satisfaction of the University, Permittee shall be held responsible for and liable to the University for payment of any and all costs incurred by the University to restore the space to its original condition, including any pre or post-event expenses incurred by the University to remove signage installed in non-approved locations.
  - 15. This Permit shall be interpreted according to the laws of the State of New York.
- 16. This Permit and attached Exhibits A, A-1, B and C constitute the entire agreement between the parties hereto. All previous communications between the parties, whether written or oral, with reference to the subject matter of this Permit, are hereby superseded.
  - 17. All events that serve alcohol MUST comply with University Alcohol Policy. (see <a href="http://studentaffairs.stonybrook.edu/jud/alcohol.shtml">http://studentaffairs.stonybrook.edu/jud/alcohol.shtml</a>)

Violation of this policy or misuse of campus facilities may result in denial of future access, disciplinary and/or legal action.

The parties to the attached contract, license, lease, amendment or other agreement of any kind (hereinafter, "contract") agree to be bound by the following clauses which are hereby made a part of the contract (the word "Contractor" herein refers to any party other than the State, whether a Contractor, licensee, lessor, lessee or any other party):

- EXECUTORY CLAUSE. In accordance with Section 41 of the State Finance Law, the State shall have no liability under this contract to the Contractor or to anyone else beyond funds appropriated and available for this contract.
- 2. Prohibition against Assignment. Except with the assignment of its right to receive payment subject to Article 5-A of the State Finance Law, the vendors(s) selected to perform the services herein will be prohibited from assigning, transferring, conveying or disposing its rights, title or interest in the contract to be awarded without the prior written consent of SUNY. Provided however that SUNY may with the concurrence of the New York Office of State Comptroller, waive prior written consent of the assignment, transfer, conveyance, sublease or other disposition of the contract if the vendor verifies to SUNY that the assignment, transfer, conveyance, sublease or other disposition is due to but not necessarily limited to, a reorganization, merger or consolidation of its business or enterprise. SUNY retains the right, as provided in Section 138 of the State Finance Law to accept or reject an assignment, transfer, conveyance, sublease or other disposition of the contract by the vendor. The Contractor may, however, assign its right to receive payment without the State's prior written consent unless this contract concerns Certificates of Participation pursuant to Article 5-A of the State Finance Law.
- COMPTROLLER'S APPROVAL. accordance with Section 112 of the State Finance Law, Section 355 of the State Education Law, and 8 NYCRR 316, (a) for a State University campus or health care facility certified by the Vice Chancellor and Chief Financial Officer, if this contract exceeds \$250,000 for commodities, services, printing or construction, or (b) for a State University campus not certified by the Vice Chancellor and Chief Financial Officer, if this is a contract for commodities, services, printing or construction which exceeds \$50,000 or which exceeds \$75,000 by a State University health care facility not certified by the Vice Chancellor and Chief Financial Officer, or (c) if this is an amendment for any amount to a contract which, as so amended, exceeds said statutory amounts, or (d) if, by this contract, the State agrees to give something other than money, when the value or reasonably estimated value of such consideration exceeds \$10,000, it shall not be valid, effective or binding upon the State until it has been approved by the State Comptroller and filed in the Comptroller's office.
- 4. WORKERS' COMPENSATION BENEFITS. In accordance with Section 142 of the State Finance Law, this contract shall be void and of no force and effect unless the Contractor shall provide and maintain coverage during the life of this contract for the benefit of such employees as are required to be covered by the provisions of the Workers' Compensation Law.
- 5. NON-DISCRIMINATION REQUIREMENTS. To the extent required by Article 15 of the Executive Law (also known as the Human Rights Law), and all other State and Federal statutory and constitutional nondiscrimination provisions, Contractor will not discriminate against any employee or applicant for employment because of race, creed, color, sex, national origin, sexual orientation, age, disability, genetic predisposition or carrier status, or marital status. Furthermore, in accordance with Section 220-e of the Labor Law, if this is a contract for the construction, alteration or repair of any public building or public work or for the manufacture, sale or distribution of materials, equipment or supplies, and to the extent that this contract shall be performed within the State of New York, Contractor agrees that neither it nor its subcontractors shall, by reason of race, creed, color, disability, sex or national origin: (a) discriminate in hiring against any New York State citizen who is qualified and available to perform the work; or (b) discriminate against or intimidate any employee hired for the performance of work under this contract. If this is a building service contract as defined Section 230 of the

- Labor Law, then, In accordance with Section 239 thereof, Contractor agrees that neither it nor its subcontractors shall, by reason of race, creed, color, national origin, age, sex or disability: (a) discriminate in hiring against any New York State citizen who is qualified and available to perform the work; or (b) discriminate against or intimidate any employee hired for the performance of work under this contract. Contractor is subject to fines of \$50.00 per person per day for any violation of Section 220-e or Section 239 as well as possible termination of this contract and forfeiture of all moneys due hereunder for a second or subsequent violation.
- 6. WAGE AND HOURS PROVISIONS. If this is a public work contract covered by Article 8 of the Labor Law or a building service contract covered by Article 9 thereof, neither Contractor's employees nor the employees of its subcontractors may be required or permitted to work more than the number of hours or days stated in said statutes, except as otherwise provided in the Labor Law and as set forth in prevailing wage and supplement schedules issued by the State Labor Department. Furthermore, Contractor and its subcontractors must pay at least the prevailing wage rate and pay or provide the prevailing supplements, including the premium rates for overtime pay, as determined by the State Labor Department in accordance with the Labor Law.
- 7. NON-COLLUSIVE BIDDING REQUIREMENT, In accordance with Section 139-d of the State Finance Law, if this contract was awarded based on the submission of competitive bids: (a) by submission of its bid, Contractor (Bidder) certifies, and each person signing on behalf of the Bidder certifies, and in the case of a joint bid each party thereto certifies as to its own organization, under penalty of perjury, that to the best of its knowledge and belief: (1) the prices in this bid have been arrived at independently without collusion, consultation, communication or agreement for the purpose of restricting competition, as to any matter relating to such prices, with any other bidder or with any competitor, (2) unless otherwise required by law, the prices which have been quoted in this bid have not been knowingly disclosed by the Bidder and will not be knowingly disclosed by the Bidder prior to opening, directly or indirectly, to any other bidder or to any competitor; and (3) no attempt has been made or will be made by the Bidder to induce any other person, partnership or corporation to submit or not to submit a bid for the purpose of restricting competition.
- (b) A bid shall not be considered for award nor shall any award be made where (a) (1), (2) and (3) above have not been complied with; provided however, that if in any case the Bidder cannot make the foregoing certification, the Bidder shall so state and shall furnish with the bid a signed statement which sets forth in detail the reasons therefor.
- 8. INTERNATIONAL BOYCOTT PROHIBITION, In accordance with Section 220-f of the Labor Law and Section 139-h of the State Finance Law, if this contract exceeds \$5,000, the Contractor agrees, as a material condition of the contract, that neither the Contractor nor any substantially owned or affiliated person, firm, partnership or corporation has participated, is participating, or shall participate in an international boycott in violation of the federal Export Administration Act of 1979 (50 USC App. Sections 2401 et seq.) or regulations thereunder. If such Contractor, or any of the aforesaid affiliates of Contractor, is convicted or is otherwise found to have violated sald laws or regulations upon the final determination of the United States Commerce Department or any other appropriate agency of the United States subsequent to the contract's execution, such contract, amendment or modification thereto shall be rendered forfeit and void. The Contractor shall so notify the State Comptroller within five (5) business days of such conviction, determination or disposition of appeal (2 NYCRR 105.4).

- 9. SET-OFF RIGHTS. The State shall have all of its common law, equitable and statutory rights of set-off. These rights shall include, but not be limited to, the State's option to withhold for the purposes of set-off any moneys due to the Contractor under this contract up to any amounts due and owing to the State with regard to this contract, any other contract with any State department or agency, including any contract for a term commencing prior to the term of this contract, plus any amounts due and owing to the State for any other reason including, without limitation, tax delinquencies or monetary penalties relative thereto. The State shall exercise its set-off rights in accordance with normal State practices including, in cases of set-off pursuant to an audit, the finalization of such audit by the State agency, its representatives, or the State Comptroller.
- 10. RECORDS. The Contractor shall establish and maintain complete and accurate books, records, documents, accounts and other evidence directly pertinent to performance under this contract (hereinafter, collectively, "the Records"). The Records must be kept for the balance of the calendar year in which they were made and for six (6) additional years thereafter. The State Comptroller, the Attorney General and any other person or entity authorized to conduct an examination, as well as the agency or agencies involved in this contract, shall have access to the Records during normal business hours at an office of the Contractor within the State of New York or, if no such office is available, at a mutually agreeable and reasonable venue within the State, for the term specified above for the purposes of inspection, auditing and copying. The State shall take reasonable steps to protect from public disclosure any of the Records which are exempt from disclosure under Section 87 of the Public Officers Law (the "Statute") provided that: (i) the Contractor shall timely inform an appropriate State official, in writing, that said Records should not be disclosed; and (iii) said Records shall be sufficiently identified; and (iii) designation of said Records as exempt under the Statute is reasonable. Nothing contained herein shall diminish, or in any way adversely affect, the State's right to discovery in any pending or future litigation.
- 11. IDENTIFYING INFORMATION AND PRIVACY NOTIFICATION. (a) Federal Employer identification Number and/or Federal Social Security Number. All invoices or New York State standard vouchers submitted for payment for the sale of goods or services or the lease of real or personal property to a New York State agency must include the payee's identification number, i.e., the seller's or lessor's identification number. The number is either the payee's Federal employer identification number or Federal social security number, or both such numbers when the payee has both such numbers. Failure to include this number or numbers may delay payment. Where the payee does not have such number or numbers, the payee, on its invoice or New York State standard voucher, must give the reason or reasons why the payee does not have such number or numbers.
- (b) Privacy Notification. (1) The authority to request the above personal information from a seller of goods or services or a lessor of real or personal property, and the authority to maintain such information, is found in Section 5 of the State Tax Law. Disclosure of this information by the seller or lessor to the State is mandatory. The principal purpose for which the information is collected is to enable the State to identify individuals, businesses and others who have been delinquent in filing tax returns or may have understated their tax liabilities and to generally identify persons affected by the taxes administered by the Commissioner of Taxation and Finance. The information will be used for tax administration purposes and for any other purpose authorized by law.
- (2) The personal information is requested by the purchasing unit of the agency contracting to purchase the goods or services or lease the real or personal property covered by this contract or lease. The information is maintained in New York State's Central

Accounting System by the Director of Accounting Operations, Office of the State Comptroller, AESOB, Albany, New York 12236.

- 12. EQUAL EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITIES FOR MINORITIES AND WOMEN. (a) In accordance with Section 312 of the Executive Law, if this contract is: (i) a written agreement or purchase order instrument, providing for a total expenditure in excess of \$25,000.00, whereby a contracting agency is committed to expend or does expend funds in return for labor, services, supplies, equipment, materials or any combination of the foregoing, to be performed for, or rendered or furnished to the contracting agency; or (ii) a written agreement in excess of \$100,000,00 whereby a contracting agency is committed to expend or does expend funds for the acquisition, construction, demolition, replacement, major repair or renovation of real property and improvements thereon; or (iii) a written agreement in excess of \$100,000.00 whereby the owner of a State assisted housing project is committed to expend or does expend funds for the acquisition, construction, demolition, replacement, major repair or renovation of real property and improvements thereon for such project, then:
- (1) The Contractor will not discriminate against employees or applicants for employment because of race, creed, color, national origin, sex, age, disability or marital status, and will undertake or continue existing programs of affirmative action to ensure that minority group members and women are afforded equal employment opportunities without discrimination. - (2) at the request of the contracting agency, Contractor shall request each employment agency, labor union, or authorized representative of workers with which it has a collective bargaining or other agreement or understanding, to furnish a written statement that such employment agency, labor union or representative will not discriminate on the basis of race, creed, color, national origin, sex, age, disability or marital status and that such union or representative will affirmatively cooperate in the implementation of the contractor's obligations therein; and

(b) Contractor will include the provisions of "1", "2" and "3", above, in every subcontract over \$25,000,00 for the construction, demolition, replacement, major repair, renovation, planning or design of real property and improvements thereon (the "Work") except where the Work is for the beneficial use of the Contractor. Section 312 does not apply to: (i) work, goods or services unrelated to this contract; or (ii) smployment outside New York State; or (iii) banking services, insurance policies or the sale of securities. The State shall consider compliance by a contractor or subcontractor with the requirements of any federal law concerning equal employment opportunity which effectuates the purpose of this section. The contracting agency shall determine whether the imposition of the requirements of the provisions hereof duplicate or conflict with any such federal law and if such duplication or conflict exists, the contracting agency shall waive the applicability of Section 312 to the extent of such duplication or conflict. Contractor will comply with all duly promulgated and lawful rules and regulations of the Governor's Office of Minority and Women's Business Development pertaining hereto.

- 13. CONFLICTING TERMS. In the event of a conflict between the terms of the contract (including any and all attachments thereto and amendments thereof) and the terms of this Exhibit A, the terms of this Exhibit
- 14. GOVERNING LAW. This contract shall be governed by the laws of the State of New York except where the Federal supremacy clause requires
- LATE PAYMENT. Timeliness of payment and any Interest to be paid to Contractor for late payment shall be governed by Article 11-A of the State Finance Law to the extent required by law.
- 16. NO ARBITRATION. Disputes involving this contract, including the breach or alleged breach thereof, may not be submitted to binding arbitration (except where statutorily authorized) but must, instead, be heard in a court of competent jurisdiction of the State of New York
- 17. SERVICE OF PROCESS. In addition to the methods of service allowed by the State Civil Practice Law & Rules ("CPLR"), Contractor hereby consents to service of process upon it by registered or certified mall, return receipt requested. Service hereunder shall be complete upon Contractor's actual receipt of process or upon the State's receipt of the return thereof by the United States Postal Service as refused or undeliverable. Contractor must promptly notify the State, in writing, of each and every change of address to which service of process can be made. Service by the State to the last known address shall be sufficient. Contractor will have thirty (30) calendar days after service hereunder is complete in which to respond.
- 18. PROHIBITION ON PURCHASE OF TROPICAL HARDWOODS. The Contractor certifies and warrants that all wood products to be used under this contract award will be in accordance with, but not limited to, the specifications and provisions of State Finance Law §165 (Use of Tropical Hardwoods), which prohibits purchase and use of tropical hardwoods. unless specifically exempted, by the State or any governmental agency or political subdivision or public benefit corporation. Qualification for an exemption under this law will be the responsibility of the contractor to establish to meet with the approval of the State. In addition, when any portion of this contract involving the use of woods, whether supply or installation, is to be performed by any subcontactor, the prime Contractor will indicate and certify in the submitted bid proposal that the subcontractor has been informed and is in compliance with specifications and provisions regarding use of tropical hardwoods as detailed in §165 of the State Finance Law. Any such use must meet with the approval of the State, otherwise, the bid may not be considered responsive. Under bidder certification, proof of qualification for exemption will be the responsibility of the Contractor to meet with the approval of the State.
- 19. MacBRIDE FAIR EMPLOYMENT PRIN-CIPLES. In accordance with Section 165(5) of the State Finance Law, the Contractor hereby stipulates that the Contractor and any individual or legal entity in which the Contractor holds a ten percent or greater ownership interest and any Individual or legal entity that holds a ten percent or greater ownership interest in the Contractor either (A) have no business operations in Northern Ireland, or (B) shall take lawful steps in good faith to conduct any business operations in Northern Ireland in accordance with the MacBride Fair Employment Principles (as described in Section 165(5) of the State Finance Law), and shall permit independent monitoring of compliance with such principles

#### 20. OMNIBUS PROCUREMENT ACT OF 1992.

- (a) In accordance with the Omnibus Procurement Act of 1992, it is the policy of NYS to encourage the use of NYS contractors and suppliers, and to promote the participation of minority- and women-owned businesses where possible, in the procurement of goods and services. Information concerning the availability of NYS subcontractors and suppliers is available from the NYS Dept. of Economic Development, which shall also include the Directory of Certified Minority- and Womenowned Businesses.
- (b) Subsequent to award of procurement contracts in an amount estimated to be \$1,000,000 or more, contractors will be required to document their efforts to encourage the participation of NYS business enterprises as suppliers and subcontractors by showing that they have (i) solicited bids in a timely and adequate manner from NYS business enterprises including certified minority- or women-owned businesses, or (ii) contacted the NYS Dept. of Economic Development to obtain listings of NYS business enterprises, or (iii) placed notices for subcontractors or suppliers in newspapers, journals or other trade publications distributed in NYS, or (iv) participated in bidder outreach conferences. If a contractor determines that NY business enterprises are not available to participate in such contract, the contractor shall provide a statement indicating the method by which such determination was made. If a contractor does not intend to use subcontractors, the contractor shall provide a statement verifying such intent. Contractors shall also attest to compliance with the Federal Equal Employment Opportunity Act of 1972 (P.L. 92-261), as amended, and document efforts to provide notification to NYS residents of employment opportunities through listing any positions with the Community Services Division of the NYS Dept. of Labor, or provide for such notification in such manner as is consistent with existing collective bargaining agreements.
- (c) Bidders located in foreign countries are notified that SUNY may assign or otherwise transfer offset credits created by any procurement contract of \$1,000,000 or more to third parties located in New York

#### 21. RECIPROCITY AND SANCTIONS

PROVISIONS. Bidders are hereby notified that if their principal place of business is located in a country, nation, province, state or political subdivision that penalizes New York State vendors, and if the goods or services they offer will be substantially produced or performed outside New York State, the Omnibus Procurement Act of 1994 and 2000 amendments (Chapter 684 and Chapter 383, respectively) require that they be denied contracts which they would otherwise obtain. Contact the Department of Economic Development, Division for Small Business, 30 South Pearl Street, Albany, New York 12245, for a current list of jurisdictions subject to this provision

22. PURCHASES OF APPAREL. In accordance with State Finance Law Section 162(4-a), the State shall not purchase any apparel from any vendor unable or unwilling to provide documentation as part of its bid (i) attesting that such apparet was manufactured in compliance with all applicable labor and occupational safety laws, including, but not limited to, child labor laws, wage and hours laws and workplace safety laws, and (ii) stating, if known, the names and addresses of each subcontractor and all manufacturing plants to be utilized by the bidder.

THE FOLLOWING PROVISIONS SHALL APPLY ONLY TO THOSE CONTRACTS TO WHICH A HOSPITAL OR OTHER HEALTH SERVICE FACILITY IS A PARTY

23. Notwithstanding any other provision in this contract, the hospital or other health service facility remains responsible for insuring that any service provided pursuant to this contract complies with all pertinent provisions of Federal, state and local statutes, rules and regulations. In the foregoing sentence, the word "service" shall be construed to refer to the health care service rendered by the hospital or other health service facility.

24. (a) In accordance with the 1980 Omnibus Reconciliation Act (Public Law 96-499), Contractor hereby agrees that until the expiration of four years after the furnishing of services under this agreement, Contractor shall make available upon written request to the Secretary of Health and Human Services, or upon request, to the Comptroller General of the United States or any of their duly authorized representatives, copies of this contract, books, documents and records of the Contractor that are necessary to certify the nature and extent of the

(b) If Contractor carries out any of the duties of the contract hereunder, through a subcontract having a value or cost of \$10,000 or more over a twelve-month period, such subcontract shall contain a clause to the effect that, until the expiration of four years after the furnishing of such services pursuant to such subcontract, the subcontractor shall make available upon written request to the Secretary of Health and Human Services or upon request to the Comptroller General of the United States, or any of their duly authorized representatives, copies of the subcontract and books, documents and records of the subcontractor that are necessary to verify the nature and extent of the costs of such subcontract.

(c) The provisions of this section shall apply only to such contracts as are within the definition established by the Health Care Financing Administration, as may be amended or modified from time to time.

 DEFINITIONS. The following terms shall be defined in accordance with Section 312 of the Executive Law:

STATE CONTRACT herein referred to as "State Contract", shall mean (i) a written agreement or purchase order instrument, providing for a total expenditure in excess of \$25,000.00, whereby a contracting agency is committed to expend or does expend funds in return for labor, services, supplies, equipment, materials or any combination of the foregoing, to be performed for, or rendered or furnished to the contracting agency; or (ii) a written agreement in excess of \$100,000.00 whereby a contracting agency is committed to expend or does expend funds for the acquisition,

construction, demolition, replacement, major repair or renovation of real property and improvements thereon; or (iii) a written agreement in excess of \$100,000.00 whereby the owner of a State assisted housing project is committed to expend or dose expend funds for the acquisition, construction, demolition, replacement, major repair or renovation of real property and improvements thereon for such project. For purposes of this agreement, the term "services" shall not include banking relationships, the issuance of insurance policies and contracts, or contracts with a contracting agency for the sale of bonds, notes or other securities.

SUBCONTRACT herein referred to as "Subcontract", shall mean any agreement providing for a total expenditure in excess of \$25,000 for construction, demolition, replacement. major repair, renovation. planning or design of real property and improvements thereon between a contractor and any individual, partnership, corporation, or not-for-profit corporation, in which a portion of a contractor's obligation under a State Contract is undertaken or assumed, but shall not include any construction, demolition, replacement, major repair, renovation, planning or design of real property and improvements thereon for the beneficial use of contractor.

WOMEN-OWNED BUSINESS ENTER. PRISE herein referred to as "WBE", shall mean a business enterprise, including a sole proprietorship, partnership, or corporation that is: (a) at least fifty-one percent owned by one or more United States citizens or permanent resident aliens who are women; (b) an enterprise in which the ownership interest of such women is real, substantial and continuing; (c) an enterprise in which such women ownership has and exercises the authority to control independently the day-today business decisions of the enterprise; and (d) an enterprise authorized to do business in this State and independently owned and operated.

MINORITY-OWNED BUSINESS ENTER-PRISE herein referred to as "MBE", shall mean a business enterprise, including a sole proprietorship, partnership, or corporation that is: (a) at least fifty-one percent owned by one or more minority group members; (b) an enterprise in which such minority ownership interest is real, substantial and continuing; (c) an enterprise in which such minority ownership has and exercises the authority to control the day-to-day independently business decisions of the enterprise; and (d) an enterprise authorized to do business in this State and independently owned and operated.

MINORITY GROUP MEMBER shall mean a United States citizen or permanent resident alien who is and can demonstrate membership in one of the following groups: (a) Black persons having origins in any of the Black African racial groups; (b) Hispanic persons of Mexican Puerto Rican. Dominican, Cuban, Central or South American of either Indian or Hispanic origin, regardless of race; (c) Native American or Alaskan native persons having origins in any of the original peoples of North America. (d) Asian and Pacific Islander persons having origins in any of the Far East countries, South East Asia, the Indian subcontinent or Pacific

CERTIFIED BUSINESS shall mean a business verified as a minority or womenowned business enterprise pursuant to section 314 of the Executive Law.

- II. TERMS. The parties to the attached State Contract agree to be bound by the following provisions which are made a part hereof (the word "contractor" herein refers to any party other than the State University):
- As a pre-condition for the award of any State Contract, contractor agrees to submit an Equal Employment Opportunity (EEO) Policy Statement which conforms with the following provisions:
- (a) Contractor will not discriminate against employees or applicants for employmet because of race, creed, color, national origin, sex, age, disability or marital status, and will undertake or continue existing programs of affirmative action to ensure that minority group members and women are afforded equal employment opportunities without discrimination. Affirmative Acton shall mean recruitment. employment, iob assignment, promotion. up-grading. demolition, transfer, layoff, or termination and rates of pay or other forms of compensation.
- (b) At the request of State University, contractor shall request each employment agency, labor union, or authorized representative

of workers with which it has a collective bargaining or other agreement or understanding, to furnish a written statement that such employment agency, labor union or representative will not discriminate on the basis of race, creed, color, national origin, sex, age, disability or marital status and that such union or representative will affirmatively cooperate in the implementation of contractor's obligations therein.

- (c) Contractor shall state, in all solicitation or advertisements for employees, that, in the performance of State Contract, all qualified applicants will be afforded equal employment opportunities without discrimination because of race, creed, color, national origin, sex, age, disability or marital status.
- (d) Contractor will include the provisions of "a", "b" and "c", above, in every Subcontract over \$25,000.00.
- Contractor shall indicate whether it is able to separate out from its entire work force that portion of its work force which will be utilized in the performance of this State Contract
- 3. For State Contracts which provide labor, services, supplies, equipment or materials, as defined above, contractor must provide a Staffing Plan of the anticipated work force to be utilized on the State Contract broken down by specified ethnic background, gender, and Federal Occupational Categories, or other appropriate categories which the agency may specify.
- 4. For contractors who are unable to separate the portion of their work force which will be utilized for the performance of this State Contract, contractor shall provide reports describing its entire work force by the specified ethnic background, gender, and Federal Occupational Categories, or other appropriate categories which the agency may specify.
- 5. If contractor fails to provide a staffing plan, or in the alternative, a description of its entire work force, State University may reject contractor's bid, unless contractor either commits to provide such information at a later date or provides a reasonable justification in writing for its failure to provide the same.
- 6. After the State Contract has been awarded. contractor shall provide a Utilization Report which breaks down and describes contractor's and every subcontractor's work force by specified ethnic background. gender, and Federal Occupational Categories. The prime contractor shall be responsible for collecting reports from its subcontractors and

providing such reports to State University. For State Contracts for construction, the Utilization Report shall be completed using the number of hours worked for each relevant job title within the Federal Occupational Categories. During the term of State Contract: construction contractors must provide a Utilization Report on a monthly basis; contractors providing labor, services, supplies, equipment or materials, who are unable to separate out their work force must provide Utilization reports on a semi-annual basis; all other contractors must provide Utilization Reports every three months.

- 7. Contractor shall provide State University reports of its compliance with the terms of Article 15-A of the Executive Law as may be required by State University.
- 8. PARTICIPATION BY MINORITY GROUP MEMBERS AND WOMEN. State University shall determine whether contractor has made conscientious and active efforts to employ and utilize minority group members and women to perform this State Contract based upon an analysis of the following factors:
- (a) Whether contractor established and maintained a current list of recruitment sources for minority group members and women, and whether contractor provided written notification to such recruitment sources that contractor had employment opportunities at the time such opportunities became available.
- (b) Whether contractor sent letters to recruiting sources, labor unions, or authorized representatives of workers with which contractor has a collective bargaining or other agreement or understanding requesting assistance in locating minority group members and women for employment.
- (c) Whether contractor disseminated its EEO policy by including it in any advertising in the news media, and in particular, in minority and women news media.
- (d) Whether contractor has attempted to provide information concerning its EEO policy to subcontractors with which it does business or had anticipated doing business.
- (e) Whether internal procedures exist for, at a minimum, annual dissemination of the EEO policy to employees, specifically to employees having any responsibility for hiring, assignment, layoff, termination, or other employment decisions. Such dissemination may occur through distribution of employee policy manuals and handbooks, annual reports, staff meetings and public postings.
- (f) Whether contractor encourages and utilizes minority group members and

women employees to assist in recruiting other employees.

- (g) Whether contractor has apprentice training programs approved by the N.Y.S. Department of Labor which provides for training and hiring of minority group members and women.
- (h) Whether the terms of this section have been incorporated into each Subcontract which is entered into by the prime contractor.
- 9. PARTICIPATION BY MINORITY AND WOMEN-OWNED BUSINESS ENTERPRISES. Based upon an analysis of the following factors, the State University shall determine whether contractor has made conscientious and active efforts to provide for meaningful participation by minority-owned and women-owned business enterprises which have been certified by DMWBD:
- (a) Whether contractor has actively solicited bids for Subcontracts from qualified MWBEs, including those firms listed on the Directory of Certified Minority and Women-Owned Business Enterprises, and has documented its efforts, including names and addresses of firms contacted, and the reasons why any such firm was not selected to participate on the project.
- (b) Whether contractor has attempted to make project plans and specifications available to firms who are not members of associations with plan rooms and reduce fees for firms who are disadvantaged.
- (c) Whether contractor has utilized the services of organizations which provide technical assistance in connection with M/WBE participation.
- (d) Whether prime contractor has structured its subcontracts so that opportunities exist to complete smaller portions of work.
- (e) Whether contractor has encouraged the formation of joint ventures, partnerships, or other similar arrangements among subcontractors.
- (f) Whether contractor has requested the services of the Department of Economic Development (DED) and Job Development Authority (JDA) to assist subcontractors' efforts to satisfy bonding requirement.
- (g) Whether contractor has made progress payments promptly to its subcontractors.
- (h) Whether the terms of this section have been incorporated into each Subcontract which is entered into by the prime

contractor.

It shall be the responsibility of prime contractor to ensure compliance by every subcontractor with these provisions.

- 10. GOALS, (a) GOALS FOR MINORITY AND WOMEN WORK FORCE PARTICIPATION. (i) State University shall include relevant work force availability data, which is provided by the N.Y.S. Department of Economic Development the Division of Women's Minority and Business Development, in all documents which solicit bids for State Contracts and shall make efforts to assist contractors in utilizing such data to determine expected levels of participation for minority group members and women on State Contracts.
- (ii) Contractor shall exert good faith efforts to achieve such goals for minority and women's participation. To successfully achieve such goals, the employment of minority group members and women by contractor must be substantially uniform during the entire term of this State Contract. In addition, contractor should not participate in the transfer of employees from one employer or project to another for the sole purpose of achieving goals for minority and women's participation.
- (b) GOALS FOR MINORITY AND WOMEN-OWNED BUSINESS ENTER-PRISES PARTICIPATION. For all State Contracts in excess of \$100,000.00 whereby State University is committed to expend or does expend funds for the acquisition, construction, demolition, replacement, major repair or renovation of real property and improvements thereon, Contractor shall exert good faith efforts to achieve a participation goal of three-percent (3%) for Certified Minority-Owned Business Enterprises and three-percent (3%) for Certified Women-Owned Business Enterprises.
- 11. ENFORCEMENT. State University will be responsible for enforcement of each contractor's compliance with these provisions Contractor, and each subcontractor, shall permit State University access to its books, records and accounts for the purpose of investigating and determining whether contractor or subcontractor is in compliance with the requirements of Article 15-A of the Executive Law. If State University determines that a contractor or subcontractor may not be in compliance with these provisions, State University may make every reasonable effort to resolve the issue and assist the contractor or subcontractor in its efforts to comply with these provisions. If State University is unable to resolve the issue of noncompliance, State University may file a complaint with the Division of Minority and Women's Business Development (DMWBD).
