- Applicants must have a 2.5 minimum GPA and must meet Beville State placement requirements for dual enrollment classes.
- Students who did **NOT** make a 70 or higher in a dual enrollment class during the 2021-22 school year are **NOT** eligible to apply for this scholarship.
