Called to order at 4pm.


This solar project is the 1st community solar project in the state. Trajectory has approval to set up with Ameren. There are 5 other projects tied into this community project. Building permits are needed from the village. Construction costs and details were shared. There continue to be supply chain issues. We need to know who owns the small parcel of land behind Burnzee's and in the section of land between the solar array: Is it Peoria County or the Brimfield Village? Holly Williams from the Illinois Energy Consortium will be discussing billing and savings options; the current potential of cost savings was discussed. Construction is set to begin in the summer of 2024 and be completed in the summer of 2025. There could be work-based learning options with this project. The representatives from Trajectory mentioned that there is no cost to subscribe to be part of the project for homes and properties. Application cards are located at teh village hall. Lastly, there was mention of building a 7 foot high fence around the perimeter of the solar array.
