Testing and Accountability

Dr. Sharon Johnson, Director of Testing and Accountability, presented the 2008-2009 ABCs/AYP Report. Dr. Johnson stated that 23 of the 30 schools made either high growth or expected growth. Randolph County Schools had 50% of its schools making expected growth compared to the state's 41.5% and 70% of the schools named School of Progress compared with the state's 43%. The performance of the Randolph County Schools students on state-mandated tests improved significantly in 2008-2009. The factors contributing to the improvements were student retest results being included in the performance composite portion of the state ABCs model for the first time in 2008-2009, the support of the school administration, staff and community and also through the Professional Learning Communities.

2009 Graduation Statistical Information and Scholarship Report

Kim Johnson, Director of Secondary Education, shared 2009 graduating class statistical information: 1,034 diplomas were issued, 24 certificates were issued, 2 foreign exchange students received a certificate, 33.17% are going to public and/or private four-year colleges, 50.77% are going to community colleges, private junior colleges, and trade schools; 5.42 % are entering the military, and 9.38% are entering the workforce. The total monies awarded to Randolph County graduates toward furthering their education was \$13,300,825.00.

Budget Information Update

Todd Lowe, Finance Officer, stated the budget from the state was received on Saturday, August 15, 2009. The state allotments received had not improved from previous predictions, but allotments were also not any worse than the previous information. The Budget Resolution will be presented for approval at the Board meeting in September.

Dental Program

Diana Graves, school nurse, presented information concerning a mobile dental program. The dental van comes to the school site. The goal is to provide comprehensive services to children who do not normally receive routine and ongoing dental care. The schools provide forms for parents to fill out and return for children needing a dentist. The Friendly Neighborhood Dental Van (FNDV) picks up the forms and coordinates its visits every six months with a school representative, usually a nurse or counselor. All dental care is done on a mobile van parked at the school. Dental services are paid by Medicaid, N.C. Health Choice, private insurance or cash. M. Lambeth made a motion seconded by G. Lawson to pilot a mobile dental program at all elementary schools. Motion carried: 7-0.

Facility Planning and Construction Update

Marty Trotter, Assistant Superintendent of Operations, stated that Wheatmore High is continuing to progress day by day and will continue to be monitored closely. He stated we are getting closer to receiving certificate of occupancy. The furniture is being delivered and installed in the office area and Media Center along with the equipment in the cafeteria.
