Vocabulary Words-coating, contain, edible, float, purpose, store, structures, survive

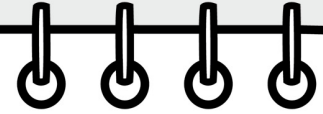
Writing-Opinion
