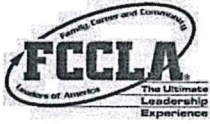

I finalized the website by making sure all the links were active on the web server. I also went through the entire website checking to make sure everything was included and looked good. I had some of the other FCCLA officers look over it and evaluate their thoughts on if I needed to add anything else. Completing this project took several months because I had to gather information and pictures from members and our advisor. Another thing that took a little time was that I had to publish the site many times to make sure every link worked correctly just as I wanted it to.
