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DROP OFF

- Carpool is in the front of the school. Stop by the lunchroom to receive an account and tag.
- Car riders can start entering the building at 7:15. This is also when buses begin unloading.
- Unless your child is eating breakfast, they will go immediately to the purple hall until 7:45. Then they will be dismissed to their class.
- If a student is not seated in their classroom by 7:55, they will be marked tardy.
- The front parking lot is closed at 7:55 each morning so if you arrive after 7:55, you must park and sign your child in at the office.
- No student drop-offs are allowed in the front parking lot.

Dismissal **INFO**

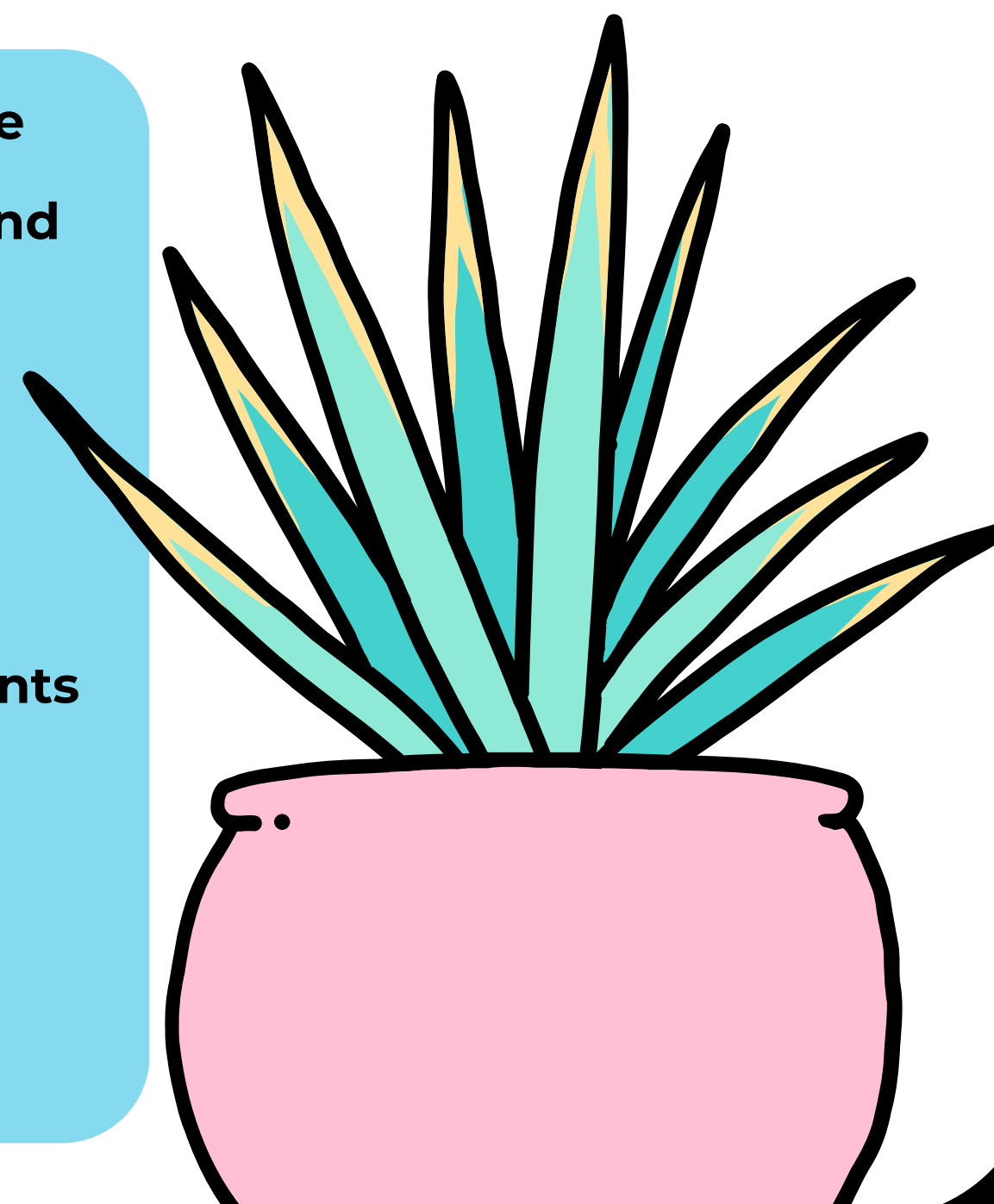
- Afternoon dismissal begins at 2:50.
- We will dismiss from the classrooms this year. Staff will help guide the students to the bus lane or front of the school for car/walker pick-up.
- If your child is a walker, you must wait by the walker pick-up signs. Parents may not wait under the breezeway.
- Parents may not park in the front parking lot to pick up walkers. Use Tara Drive instead.
- If you need to communicate a transportation change for your child, please send in a note. If it is in the middle of the day, please call the front office. We do not always have time to check ParentSquare throughout the day.

HOMework

Your child will have reading and math homework this year. More information on homework will be included on weekly newsletters and will be placed in students' R.O.A.R. Binders.

This year, students will keep agendas with important dates, including tests and quizzes, written in them. We will update you through ParentSquare and newsletters, as well as encourage students to demonstrate responsibility.

We also encourage your child to read and practice their multiplication facts at home.

ABSENCES

& Makeup Work

After an absence, please send in the excuse as soon as possible.

We encourage students to be at school each and every day. Frequent absences, tardies, and check-outs can cause students to miss crucial instructional time and can affect their grades. We do, however, understand that things can occasionally come up.

If your child is going to be absent several days in a row, it may be wise to pick up their work from the school.

The work your child missed will be given to them when they return. They will be expected to complete it within a reasonable amount of time.

DISCIPLINE Plan

This year we will be using **Class Dojo** to track student behaviors where students can earn positive, neutral, and negative points. A complete and thorough explanation of the Discipline Plan will come home soon. Students will have the opportunity to earn positive points and can spend their Dojo points on classroom passes and prizes. Neutral points are warnings. However, negative points will affect their weekly conduct grade. The weekly conduct grades will be averaged each quarter and appear on progress reports and report cards.

For daily accountability, the student will receive a consequence for each negative point earned:

- 1 point – student/teacher conference at Brain Break and reflection time
- 2 points – loss of Brain Break
- 3 points – loss of Brain Break, silent lunch, and a discipline step

For each step your child receives on their office referral, the following consequences apply:

Step 1: Student/Teacher Conference

Step 2: Parent Notification

Step 3: Parent/Teacher/Administrator Conference

Step 4: Office Referral

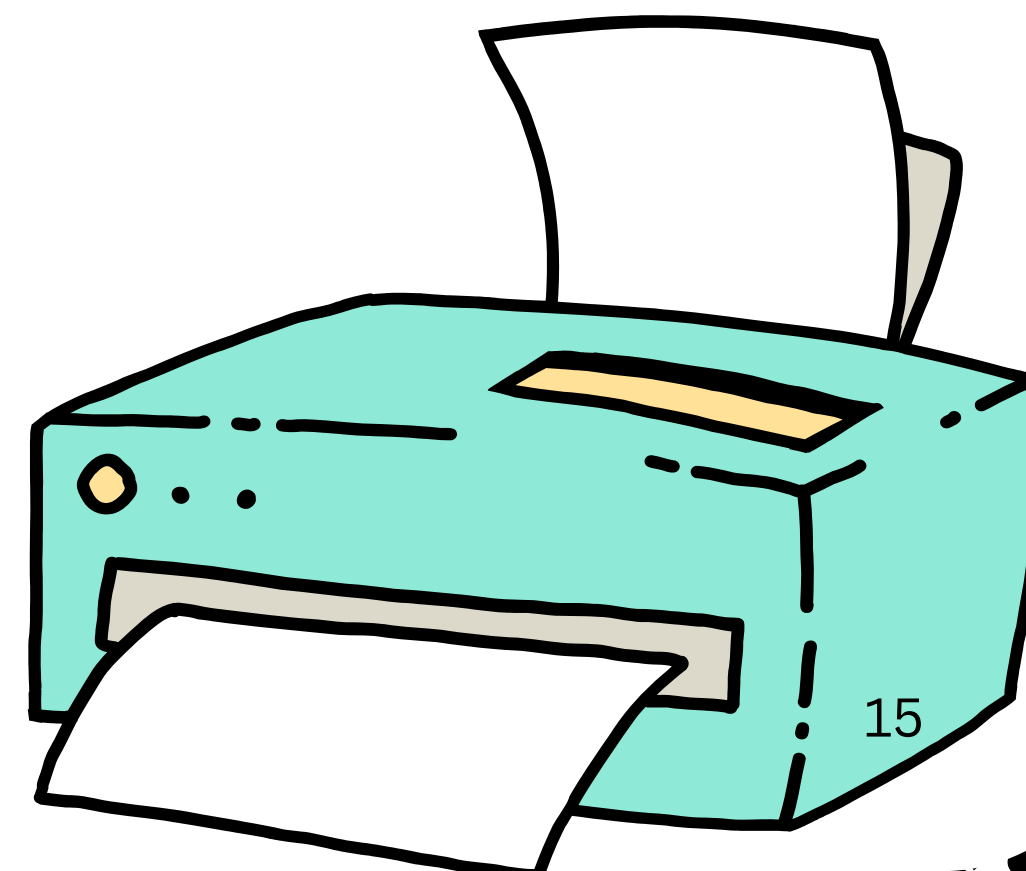
Weekly conduct grades:

- Satisfactory (S): 2 or less negative points
- Needs Improvement (N): 3-4 negative points
- Unsatisfactory (U): 5 or more negative points

Field TRIPS

We try to go on at least **one field trip per 9 weeks.** Permission slips will go home several weeks in advance. Please note that all deadlines for turning in money are **FINAL** and no money can be dropped off in the front office. Make sure that you send in correct change, because the school does not keep cash on hand.

We appreciate all the help we can get and love when parents volunteer to chaperone. We just ask that if you sign up to chaperone that you do not leave before we load the buses to return to school.

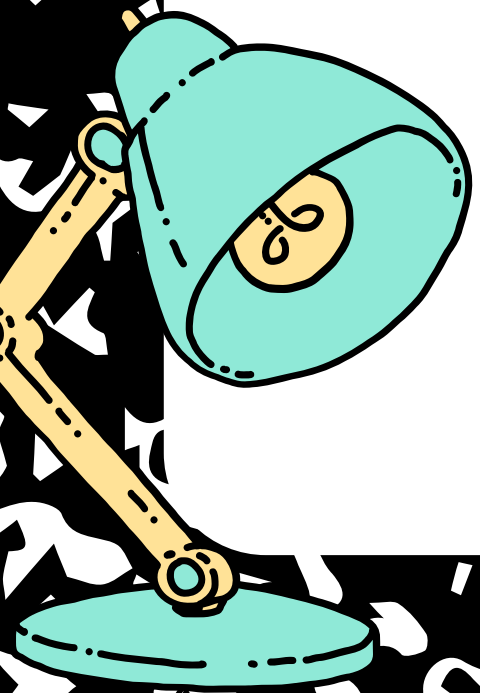


Dress

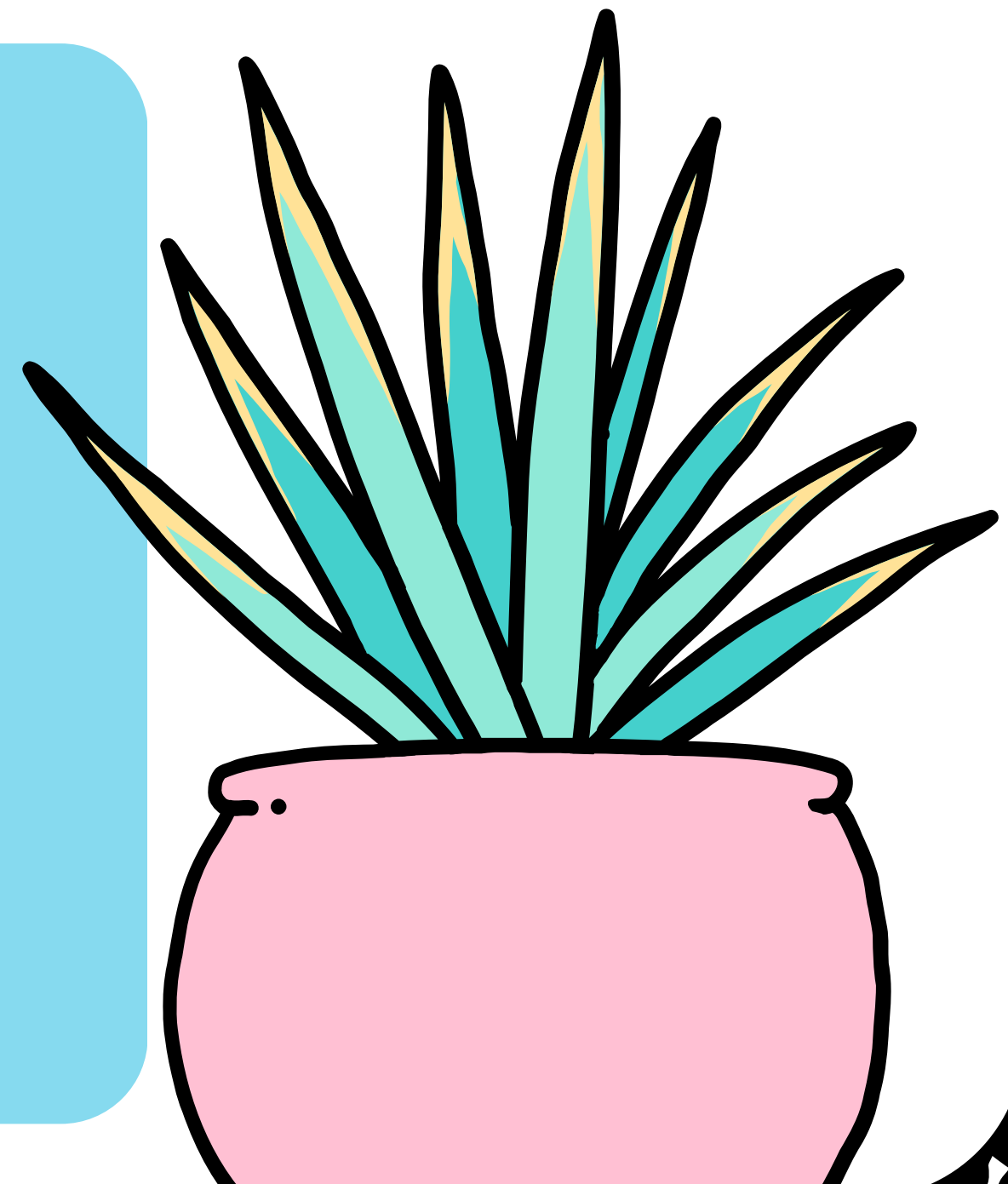
