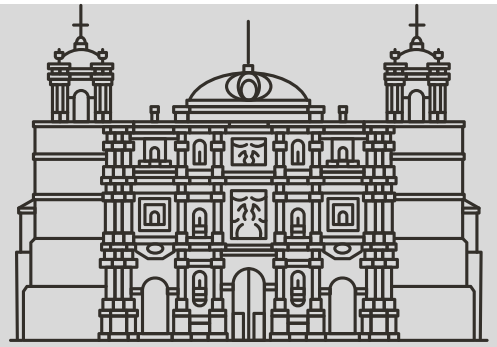

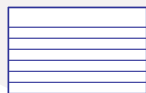

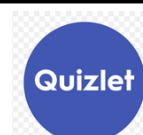

- Remember that you are responsible for your own learning. I am your guide and your best ally to help you understand better and move on. I will not remind you that you have missing work.

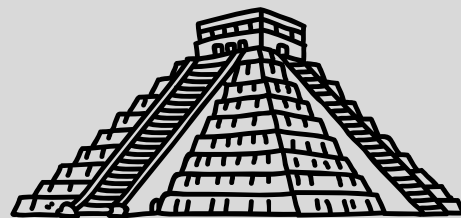

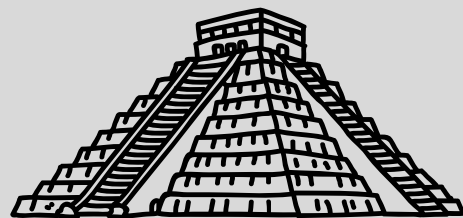
