- A tardy warning bell rings 1 min. prior to tardy bell.
- Students should get breakfast prior to tardy bell ringing for 1st period.
- Vending machines are turned off during lunches.
- Students will only be allowed to return to cars for personal items when someone is available to escort them.

If you use the the back gate on Goodwin Ave you will drop your child off on the playground side of the building. Be careful: buses are also dropping off students.




