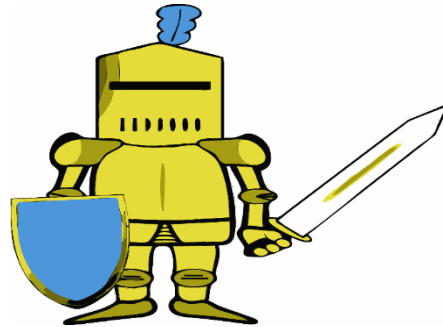

STEWART COUNTY SCHOOLS DISTRICT GOAL:

At the end of the 2024-2025 school year, the percentage of scholars scoring as a proficient or distinguished learner on the GA Milestone Tests will increase by 3%.

STEWART COUNTY ELEMENTARY SCHOOL GOAL:

Stewart County Elementary School will increase the percentage of scholars scoring proficient and distinguished on the Spring 2025 Georgia Milestones Assessments, by 3%; while decreasing the number of scholars scoring beginning learner by a minimum of 5%.

To help your child meet the district and school goals, the school, you, and your child will work together to:

SCHOOL/TEACHER RESPONSIBILITIES:

As a School/Teacher, I will:

- <Develop testing to monitor our scholars' progress on required subjects
- <Use testing results to determine and monitor our scholars' need
- <Use Knight's Time to remediate, enrich, and/or accelerate scholars' knowledge based on individual scholar's need
- <Work to create a positive learning culture and climate for our scholars
- <Have weekly Teacher Work Sessions to plan instructional ways to improve our testing results
- <Help our parents stay connected by communicating with them in different ways
- <Host Curriculum Nights to address subject areas being taught to our scholars

STUDENT RESPONSIBILITIES:

As a Scholar, I will:

- <Follow the rules of my classroom
- <Follow the 3r's of expectation: respect, responsible and ready to learn
- <Be quiet in my classroom and listen to my teacher at all times
- <Raise my hands to ask questions if I don't understand my teacher's instructions
- <Use IXL and Achieve 3000 to work on numeracy and literacy skills
- <Take care of my school's technology devices daily
- <Complete my work assignments given by my teacher
- <Talk with my parents/caregiver daily about my schoolwork
- <Share my "behavior/homework" folder with my parent/caregiver daily
- <Read daily at home to improve my reading skills

PARENT RESPONSIBILITIES:

As a parent, I will:

- <Send or transport my child to school on time daily during the school year
- <Encourage my child daily to have good and productive days at school
- <Check my child's folder daily for classwork, homework and behavior notes
- <Talk daily with my child daily about their schoolwork and behavior at school
- <Communicate with my child's teacher about concerns about schoolwork or behavior
- <Help my child improve their reading skills by reading with them at home
- <Talk with my child's teacher about assessments(tests) to help my child become a proficient or distinguished learner
