SECURITY OFFICER

BASIC FUNCTION:

Cooperate with other staff members in maintaining order on and patrolling large high school campus.

REPRESENTATIVE DUTIES:

- Patrol high school campus and adjacent areas. E

- Issue citations or make arrests where necessary. E
- Investigate large gatherings and take appropriate action. E
