Parents and guardians, if your student is going to be absent—even for partial days, please be sure to contact the front office of your school and report the absence EVERY DAY they are absent.

In order to keep our teachers in front of their class and not interrupt instruction, teachers will need at least 24 hours' notice to create homework packets.

Students are responsible for making up and turning in all missing assignments.

More than 10 unexcused absences will result in disenrollment and a report to the Tribal Prosecutor. Thank you for your understanding and for your assistance in keeping your student in the classroom.
