

WEBSTER COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION  
REGULAR SESSION  
DECEMBER 9, 2025 @ 6:00 P.M.

The Webster County Board of Education held its regular meeting on December 9, 2025 at 6:00 p.m. Linda Rogers, Donald Brown, Jimmie Johnson, and James McCullough, Interim Superintendent, were present. Landon Matthews was absent.

Linda Rogers called the special called session to order at 6:00 P.M.

A moment of silence was observed followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

Visitors were recognized by Linda Rogers.

Public comments were given by Miranda Crimes and Janie Downer.

The Board approved the tentative agenda for December 9, 2025. A motion was made by Donald Brown and seconded by Mr. Jimmie Johnson. The motion carried unanimously.

The Board approved the October 2025 Financial Report. A motion was made by Mr. Jimmie Johnson and seconded by Donald Brown. The motion carried unanimously.

The Board reviewed the reconciliation report.

The Board approved the November 11, 2025 (6:00 pm) regular session minutes. A motion was made by Donald Brown and seconded by Jimmie Johnson. The motion carried unanimously.

The Board approved the December 8, 2025 (5:00 pm) special called meeting minutes. A motion was made by Jimmie Johnson and seconded by Donald Brown. The motion carried unanimously.

The Board approved to pay SRJ Architect, Inc. in the amount of \$63.00 for renovations and modifications project from Bond Construction Funds. A motion was made by Donald Brown and seconded by Jimmie Johnson. The motion carried unanimously.

The Board approved to pay Renaissance Learning \$9,384.00 for services, Freckle, Accelerated Reader, and STAR from Local Funds. A motion was made by Mr. Jimmie Johnson and seconded by Mr. Donald Brown. The motion carried unanimously.

The Board approved to enter into a contract with The Stepping Stones Group to provide a registered behavior technician (RBT) to support identified students with behavioral needs for the remainder of the 2025-2026 school year from Special education local and state funds. A motion was made by Mr. Donald Brown and seconded by Mr. Jimmie Johnson. The motion carried unanimously.

The Board approved to pay Cartwheel \$19,900 for student mental/behavioral health services from the Student Mental/Behavioral Health Services Grant. A motion was made by Mr. Jimmie Johnson and seconded by Mr. Donald Brown. The motion carried unanimously.

The Board approved the Corrective Action Plan to be submitted to the Georgia Department of Education. A motion was made by Mr. Donald Brown and seconded by Mr. Jimmie Johnson. The motion carried unanimously.

The Board approved appoint Mr. Jake Everett as a successor board member to fill the vacant District 3 Board of Education seat. A motion was made by Mr. Donald Brown and seconded by Mr. Jimmie Johnson. The motion carried unanimously.

The Board approved the Personnel Agenda:

- a. The hiring of Mrs. Gloria Taylor for the HR/Payroll position at the Webster County Board of Education Office.

A motion was made by Mr. Jimmie Johnson and seconded by Mr. Donald Brown. The motion carried unanimously.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned at 6:43 p.m. with a motion by Donald Brown and seconded by Jimmie Johnson. The motion carried unanimously.
