

Device Protection Plan (DPP)

The Device Protection Plan (DPP) is an optional "insurance" program the District provides to protect families from costly repairs related to accidental damage or theft. Optional insurance is available to purchase for district-provided Chromebooks. The cost of this insurance is \$50 per school year or a maximum of \$150 per family. You can elect to take the insurance only during the process of enrolling your student. For those who do not purchase district-provided insurance, a \$75 incident fee will be charged per occurrence. This fee does not cover for loss of the Chromebook and/or its accessories, or damages caused by intentional misuse and/or abuse. The administration will investigate and determine if the occurrence is accidental or neglect.

If the incident that caused the damage is deemed to not be covered by the DPP coverage the user will be responsible for the full price of the repair or replacement according to the "Students without DPP coverage" fee schedule. Covered incidents will be subject to the cost of parts used to repair the Chromebook. All fees will be handled in the Admin/Business office.
