Sports Physicals Offered by FHN Tuesday, June 20, from 3-5 pm At Milledgeville School

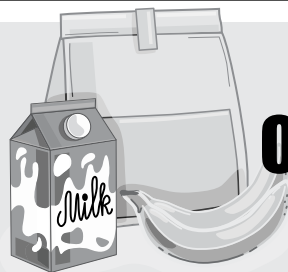
This Sports Physical meets IHSA eligibility requirements for all sports. This physical does NOT meet the requirement for K, 6th, 9th grade school physical, or for new students from out-of state.

Forms will be available in our school offices, on our district website, and at your local FHN healthcare center. A portion of the Sports Physical Form must be completed and signed by a parent BEFORE the exam. The consent for Medical Care Form must be signed and brought with the student.

Sports Physical Cost: \$25. Please make checks payable to FHN

PHYSICAL, IMMUNIZATION, DENTAL AND VISION REQUIREMENTS FOR 2023-2024

The Chadwick/Milledgeville School District requires all Pre-K, kindergarten, 6th and 9th grade students to have complete physicals and required immunizations before entering school in the fall. The Illinois Department of Public Health requirements are as follows for specific grade levels:

Children two years of age or older entering a school-operated program below the kindergarten level: A school physical, required immunizations, and a lead screening.

Children registering for kindergarten: A school physical, required immunizations, and a lead screening. They are also required to have a dental exam and a vision exam. Bring completed dental and vision exam forms to registration or have an appointment date.

Children entering 2nd grade: are required to have a dental exam. Bring completed dental exam form to registration or have an appointment date.

Children entering 6th grade: A school physical, required immunizations, and a dental exam. Bring completed exam forms to registration or have an appointment date.

Students entering 9th grade: A school physical, required immunizations, and dental exam.

Students entering 12th grade: Proof of Meningococcal Vaccination(s)

Please remember to schedule your mandated physicals and immunization updates for preschool, kindergarten, 6th and 9th grade students as early as possible. These will be requested at school registration and are due no later than September 1, 2023.

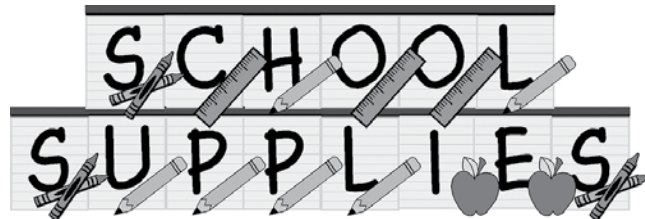
