POLICY TITLE: Credit by Examination POLICY NO: 622 PAGE 1 of 1

A student may receive credit toward high school graduation by passing an examination which assesses the student's mastery of a given subject. The examinations must be approved by the board of trustees and administered by the district, and cover the content standards included in a regular secondary education course on the subject. The student passing such examination will not be required to attend the regular school course in which the subject is taught.

A student may receive credit by examination for no more than one-half $(\frac{1}{2})$ of the total credits required for graduation and for no more than one-half $(\frac{1}{2})$ of the core credits required for graduation by this district.
