Information regarding specific dates can be found on the district's website or by calling your child's school. These assessments are an important tool used to measure students' progress and academic growth in key subjects. The NJSLA will be administered to students in grades 3 through 11 as part of the New Jersey Department of Education's statewide assessment program.

The NJSLA helps us understand how well students are mastering key skills in reading, writing, mathematics, and science. The results provide valuable insights to help improve instruction and ensure that students are prepared for future academic success. The results also fulfill state and federal requirements for assessing student learning.

What you can do to help your child succeed:

1. **Ensure your child gets plenty of rest** the night before each testing day.
2. **Provide a healthy breakfast** on the days of the test to help your child stay focused.
3. **Encourage a positive attitude** toward the assessments. Let them know the purpose is to learn how they are doing in school and to identify areas where they may need extra support.
