Master's Academy's **Center for Calling and Career** is a one-of-a-kind program designed to help students recognize their God-given gifts and step confidently toward the future He has prepared for them.

The Center provides resources for career exploration and preparation, including a strengths-based developmental approach to career decisions, career readiness, and career connections through the Director's office.



This year, every high school student has engaged in meaningful, developmentally tailored experiences—from college-prep workshops for freshmen and sophomores, to CliftonStrengths assessments for juniors, to senior sessions on viewing calling and career through a Kingdom lens. Students have toured multiple university campuses, met with admissions representatives from seven colleges, and explored career pathways through our hands-on Calling & Career Exploration Course.

Through resume building, mock interviews, spiritual gifts assessments, career research, and projects that put those gifts into action, students are learning to listen for the Lord's direction and steward their strengths well.

Looking ahead, we're excited to host our first annual **Master's Academy Christian College Fair** in partnership with NACCAP.
