JSD 171 Transportation is looking for Bus Drivers!

Please see below for a list of requirements to be a school bus driver:

- Class B CDL with passenger, school bus, and air brake endorsements
- The Transportation Department is able to provide all the training required to obtain your CDL.
- You will have to pass a skills test with a state examiner to complete the training. We reimburse you for the costs incurred.
- Must pass a DOT drug test and enroll in our random drug and alcohol testing pool.
- Must pass a DOT medical examination (every one or two years depending on the examiners determination).
- Required to maintain a minimum of ten hours of training with transportation staff every year.

Activity drivers are paid the driver wage from the time they leave until the time they return. If you are a coach/driver, you will be paid for your driving time only. Stand-by time while you are coaching will not be paid time.

The hourly rate for bus drivers for the 2024-2025 school year is \$19.51.
