

The district released an RFP for CM/GC on August 4th, with responses due August 31st. Four firms responded - CB Construction, DSL, O'Brien, and P&C Construction. All four firms were found to be competent and able to complete this project in collaboration with WRK Engineering, who will be providing project management. The district rating committee has evaluated and rated each firm's proposal, interviewed the project supervisor each firm has designated for the Cardiff Gym seismic rehabilitation project, and selected the firm they believe to be the best suited for this important project. The committee unanimously selected CB Construction for the CES Seismic CM/GC project.

SUBJECT: Clatskanie Elementary School Principal's Report to the CSD School Board

This report covers the period from **August 2023 to September 6, 2023.** I will outline key achievements, challenges, and initiatives within this timeframe.

1. Academic Excellence:

- CES will be implementing a new assessment platform **AIMSWEB to complement our RTI practices**. Staff participated in three hours of training during inservice and Billi Leinonen is championing the cause to ensure that the change in processes is as smooth, effective, and flawless as possible. For this platform there are measures for both reading and math that support CES's efforts to facilitate improved learning opportunities for all students.
- With grant dollars, CES was able to purchase a **Social Studies curriculum platform** that is elementary friendly and is based on Oregon State Standards. The certified were very thankful for the additional opportunities it provides. There is a similar opportunity in science but we are waiting on decisions on curriculum that will be enacted as the survey and planning process develops district wide. https://www.studiesweekly.com/social-studies/

2. Staff Development:

- During district and school specific in-services in August, professional practices and improvement were topics of discussion. Three areas that will be focal points are **dress code**, **cell phone use**, **and arrival/departure times**. The staff also reviewed a previously developed document of CES Professional Expectations based on the PBIS Model that is implemented schoolwide.
- Mary Bauman did a superb job instructing and leading a professional development with Certified Employees on a successful start to classroom management and schoolwide expectations. She and her team are setting up the behavior support plan for the school and she has also tackled supporting the RTI/academics, as well. She will be meeting with the Classified Staff on September 6th during the first early release to share the same information with that group with a twist as their roles are not exactly the same as classroom teachers.

3. Infrastructure and Facilities:

- **Cholla Grigsby and Clayton Hanson** worked diligently this summer and the CES building and surrounding area looks amazing. It is scrubbed from head to toe. All hallways, classrooms, general areas, and more are ready for an amazing school year. I cannot thank them both

enough for their willingness to go the extra mile.

- The new rock wall in the Cardiff gym is under construction the week of August 28-31. This is a new component for CES that was purchased with some new teacher grant funds. Ben Bauman and Jason Krause will be central to its completion and all CES students will be able to have access to it during PE specials.
- Huge thank you to the City of Clatskanie, Clatskanie PUD, Missy and Dan Smith, and the PSEA for their contributions to the playground improvements. There was significant damage to the upper and lower playground logs so that removal was necessary. The new playground structure near the Cardiff building is now complete, as well.

4. Student Engagement and Well-being:

- As Mary Bauman continues to develop her new position and support program, students will be receiving SEL/Behavior support directly from her team. They will be utilizing the stage area as a "recalibration" and/or debriefing area for students that is consistent.
- -SEL instruction will continue to be developed through the Character Strong: Purposeful People curriculum that was purchased for CES. The character trait for September is: RESPECT.

5. Community Partnerships:

- Paul Knickerbocker who is on the Board of Directors for the Snapdragon Book Foundation reached out to Lisa Christen in the library and informed her that "while we did not have enough funds to award your grant in May, we were so impressed with your application and dedication to serving students that we have selected Clatskanie Elementary School as our "Next Up" school. "Next Up" is a Snapdragon program that will directly fund our showcase school (Clatskanie Elementary School in 2023!). All donation dollars that the Snapdragon Book Foundation receives during the month of September will go towards funding your project, "SEL Matters!"" What a tremendous honor and credit to Lisa's innovative efforts to create additional opportunities for CES to serve its students better. We appreciate her more than she could know.
