- 3. Acceptance of the FY24 Financial Summary & budget update. The bank has approved the credit line to be increased to 3 million. OPEB balance as of 12/31/23 is \$172k higher than last year. Currently we are not using agency staff members. Initial review of FY25 budget will be at the next meeting on March 1st. A motion to approve FY24 financial summary & budget report was made by Mr. Granatino and seconded by Mr. Lee; unanimously approved.
- 4. Report of Director of Student Services. Finished 1st part of the DESE mid-cycle review, self-assessments, which were due at the end of January. DESE had a glitch with their new system, but it has now been fixed and they will be on site in May. The Title 2 and Discrimination policies are being updated and made into one combined policy. Policies should be ready in March for review.
- 5. Executive Director Appointment. Michael Losche has been named the Executive Director starting July 1, 2024. A motion to approve the Executive Director appointment was made by Ms. Granatino and seconded by Mr. Keegan; unanimously approved.
- 6. Other. We will be receiving a \$60K reimbursement for the chrome books we bought a few years ago. Abington contacted Rick about membership into the collaborative. A motion to end the meeting at 9:27am was made by Mr. Keegan and seconded by Mr. Lee; unanimously approved.
