




The DS School District is seeking applicants for several vacant positions



All students entering 6th grade are required by Ky. State Law to have a 6th grade physical exam and a current valid KY immuniza-



tion certificate. Immunizations that are required for all students entering the 6th grade include (1) T-Dap, (2) varicella and (1) meningococcal. Your child will have to have these immunizations once they turn 11 years of age. A sports physical will not be accepted as their 6th grade school physical. Please make arrangements with either the school clinic or your family physician. Your child will not be allowed to enter 6th grade without his/her physical and their updated immunization certificate.

ees, our new retirees plus their invited special guests.


Telisa Cotton has worn many hats through her years at Dawson Springs from her first position in Head Start to her current Elementary Reading Specialist. Ms. Cotton

Kentucky Summer Electronic Benefits Transfer (SEBT)



Students may be eligible for summer nutrition assistancel

What is SEBT?

SEBT is intended to reduce hunger and food insecurity for students who lose access to free and reduced-price meals through the National School Lunch Program (NSLP) and School Breakfast Program (SBP), during the summer when school is not in session.

Who is Eligible?

The following school aged students (aged 6-17 as of August 1st, 2023) are automatically approved for SEBT benefits and do not need to apply:

 Students that have received SNAP, KTAP and/or Kinship Care for at least one (1) month since July 1st, 2023.

Students that do not fall into the above category but are within the income eligibility limits, can apply for SEBT benefits online.

Benefit Amount!


Households can expect to receive a one-time lump sum issuance of \$120 (\$40 per summer month) per eligible student, if approved.

How Do I Apply?

SEBT benefit applications can be completed online or you can contact DCBS at 855-306-8959 with questions.

The online Application will be available at https://KYSEBT.ky.gov/ or can be accessed through https://kynect.ky.gov/benefits/ starting June 22nd, 2024.
