Description	Research into how young children learn mathematics supports a <i>learning trajectories</i> approach. In a learning trajectories approach, teachers look at where a child is developmentally within a math strand and engage the child with play-based, ageappropriate activities to move the child to the next level. This session is based on research developed by Douglas H. Clements and Julie Sarama, authors of the Pre-K curriculum <i>Connect 4 Learning</i> . The session will allow extensive time for teachers to collaboratively explore <i>Learning and Teaching with Learning Trajectories</i> [LT] ² . [LT] ² is an open-access, web-based tool for early childhood educators. Visit LearningTrajectories.org for interactive games and practical tools that support classroom learning.
