## Right to Know Notification

Right to Know Professional Qualifications of Teachers and Paraprofessionals

## Dear Parents.

In compliance with the requirements of Every Students Succeeds Act, the West Point Consolidated School District would like to inform you that you may request information about the professional qualifications of your student's teacher(s) and/or paraprofessional(s). The following information may be requested:

- Whether the student's teacher
  - o has met State qualification and licensing criteria for the grade levels and subject areas in which the teacher provides instruction;
  - o is teaching under emergency or other provisional status through which State qualifications or licensing criteria have been waived; and
  - o is teaching in the field of discipline of the certification of the teacher.
- Whether the child is provided services by paraprofessionals and, if so, their qualifications.

Your school will notify you of your child(ren)'s level of achievement in each of the State academic assessments. Additionally, we will notify you if your child(ren) has/have been assigned to a teacher for four or more consecutive weeks that is not highly qualified. We welcome any questions or concerns that you may have about the Title I program operating at your child(ren)'s school.

We appreciate your concern for your child(ren)'s education and your involvement and participation in their education.
