

LAS Links Results 2019-2020

- **The English language proficiency of all English Learners (ELs) must be assessed annually.**

In Connecticut, the assessment instrument is the Language Assessment Scales (LAS) Links.

- **In order to be deemed proficient in CT and exit EL services, students must score a 4 overall and a 4 in both Reading and Writing.**

We tested 42 students Grades K-12 using the LAS Links-**11/42** students have been exited as a result of attaining proficiency on their LAS links scores:

Quaker Farms School:

19 students tested:

11 in Kindergarten

1 in First Grade

7 in Second Grade

2 Students from Grade 2 exited

Oxford Center School:

15 students were tested:

3 in Third Grade

6 in Fourth Grade

6 in Fifth Grade

2 students from Grade 4 exited

4 students from Grade 5 exited

Great Oak Middle School:

5 students were tested:

1 in Sixth Grade

2 in Seventh Grade

2 in Eighth Grade

1 student from Sixth Grade exited

2 student from Eighth Grade exited

Oxford High School:

3 students were tested:

1 in Ninth Grade

2 in Twelfth Grade

Our EL teacher has analyzed each student's score who did not meet proficiency and has created a plan for each student that has a primary focus, secondary focus and where the student is approaching proficiency.
