Notes to Enumerators—  
1. Section 4002 as amended in 1903 governs the taking of the school census.  
2. Enumerators shall not include in the census the names of any child or children in institutions or prisons; nor the names of any child or children in asylums, almshouses, or other charitable institutions, except as follows:  
(a) Children in such institutions who regularly attend the public schools.  
(b) Children whose names are on lists of deaths recorded in each school district or city.  
(c) Children of color whose names are on lists of the district or ward where such institution is located, except children in class (a) where the parents, or either of them, reside in such city or district and in such cases the legal guardian of the child is that of the parent.  
(d) Orphaned, left boys, and other persons if entitled to be included in the census, must be reported as the residence of their parents or legal guardian.  
Section 4004 provides how children in institutions may attend school, but in no way exempts them from the census.  
3. The ages of children must be given as they are on June 1, 1915. If a child removes from the district during the twenty days preceding June 1, he must be enrolled in the district to which he is removed June 1.
