We will also have a book exchange on December 19th during our Christmas party. There is a flyer/sign up sheet for party treats in your folder with more information about this as well.



This Week's Agenda



When we add the suffix –ed to a word, we are changing it to past tense. Even though it is the same spelling, it can sound one of three ways.

/ed/this sound follows the consonants 't' and 'd' like in 'wanted' /t/this sound follows consonants that do not use your voice box, like in 'walked' and 'missed'

/d/this sound follows consonants that do use your voice box, like in 'followed' and 'whispered'
