Practice At Home

- ❖ Read and write together! After your child finishes reading a story, challenge them to add onto their story in writing OR write a retell of the main events. Pay close attention to spelling!
- ❖ Practice counting by ones, tens, and hundreds. Try counting starting at oddball numbers and keep them high – between 500 and 1,000!
- ❖ Be creative and collect data from your family together. Ask them to choose a favorite season, dessert, or sport from a list you've created. After collecting data, graph it!

This Week's Agenda

Spelling: Schwa can be spelled with the letter 'a'
"Schwa" is the /uh/ or /i/ sound that comes in the unstressed syllable of a word. It can be spelled with any vowel, but this week we are focusing on 'a'.

Examples: about, banana, America, above, amount, pasta, sofa

Reading: We will begin reading fables and folktales about pollinators. We will be writing paragraphs to retell what the story is about, and what the central message of the story is.

Math: We are practicing reading and answering questions about different kinds of graphs. We will also make different kinds of graphs to represent data we've collected.

Social Studies: We will continue learning about the importance of laws and about voting in the United States.
