Houston County High School to Host Ribbon Cutting for New Competition Gym on November 7

HOUSTON COUNTY, GA – Houston County High School will celebrate its new competition gymnasium with a ribbon cutting on November 7. A brief program will be held at 4:00 p.m., followed by the ribbon cutting and tours of the gymnasium. Any interested community members are invited to attend this event.

The gym has 45,416 square feet and will seat 2,130 fans. The facility was designed by Altman + Barrett Architects from Hahira, Ga., and the construction manager was Parrish Construction Group. Funded by the 2017-2022 Education - Special Purpose Local Option Sales Tax, the overall budget was \$11.1 million.
